In the name of God amen I Thomas Larkin in the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body but of sound mind I think to make this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it existence and my body to be disposed of in a Christian manner at the disposal of my executors whom I shall hereafter nominate and appoint secondly my will is that all my Just debts be promptly paid and settled out of my estate the balance which may remain I think proper to dispose of in the following manner I first give to my beloved Wife Rebecca Larkin after paying and settling my debts the whole use and control of my property Real and personal for and during her natural life after which term of time it is my will that it shall be divided to my children in the following manner to my eldest Daughter Margaret Dipple wife of James Dipple only one dollar that being in addition to what I have heretofore given her I give and bequeath to my son John Larkin my boy named Peter together with the tract of Land I now live on to him and his heirs forever I give and bequeath to my daughter Polly Petke my negress girl named Liza to her and her heirs &c. I give and bequeath to my son James Larkin my tract of Land adjoining Gallaways & Martins Lewis and my negress boy named Bob.

together with all stock and moveable property to
 him & his heirs and lastly I give and bequeath to
 my Daughter Catherine Larkin my negro woman
 Rachel and her child Isaac and her bed and fur-
 niture to her and her heirs forever and that she is
 to remain and retain as a home on my lands
 during the time she may remain single If in the
 will to John Larkin my son I do hereby to take her
 and keep her from any county charge and I app-
 oint my wife and John Larkin executors to this
 my last will the aforesaid distribution of my prop-
 erty is my last will and testament hereby revoking
 and annulling all former will or wills by me
 made in testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and caused my seal to be affixed on
 the 7th day of March 1818 signed sealed published
 and acknowledged in presence of us,

B. John & I will give 5 more to them and
their heirs forever and lastly I appoint Wm
B. Moore and Richard F Moore as executor to
this my last will and testament signed sealed
sealed and acknowledged in the presence of
John Hutchins & Barnett Moore
