


William Barber

 I give and bequeath to my wife Elizabeth Barber all my
 whole Estate during her natural life or widowhood
 and at her death or marriage my will is that my son
 Daniel Barber to have my four negroes Milly, Charity
 Solomon & Lily to him and his heirs for ever
 I give to my two sons Sam & Travis Barber the money
 they retained from a negro in Rockingham County
 I give to my daughter Elizabeth Barber the Bedstead
 and furniture that is called her Grand mother Barbors
 but if she claims no other but that then my will
 is that all the rest of my Estate except the negroes to
 be equally divided among the rest of my children
 not mention in my will and I do hereby constitute
 ordain & appoint my wife Eliz^a and James ~~Barber~~
 Robertson the whole & sole Executors of this my last
 will & testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and fixed my seal this 29th day of
 January 1871
