Thence I give and bequeath to my son Robert Martin the tract of land whereon I now live together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging mill &c and the following negroes namely Billy Hun Solomon his wife Rachel and her children all and Peggy after his mother's decease Peter and Edward Daniel Chua and Solomon and all their future increase to him and his heirs forever
Thence I give and bequeath to my daughter Rachel Broach the negro Lea and her daughter Caroline and all their future increase for her support during her natural life and then to descend to the heirs of her body to be equally divided among them
Thence I give and bequeath to my son John Martin the negro man named Sam to him and his heirs forever and lastly I appoint my son Robert Martin and John Martin Executors to this my last will and testament In testimony whereof I the said Robert Martin In here to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed and declared by the said Robert Martin in the presence of John Ellington & William Orrin

infirm in body but in mind and memory as perfect as usual
do make this my last will and testament disposing of my
movable estate in manner and form following. I bequeath
I give and bequeath to David Scott my son one negro
woman named Patti during his life and at his death to
his son Amos and if said woman hath increase to be
equally divided among all his children.

I give and bequeath to my grand son William Scott
all the land I now lie on supposed to be eighty one acre.
I give to my daughter Nancy Martin forty dollars in
cash to be paid out of the price of a negro hereafter men-

tioned.
I give to my two daughters Nancy Martin and Mar-
garet Semons all of my house hold and kitchen furniture
except one bed and furniture and one cow to be equally
divided between them as they think proper.

I give to my daughter Margaret Semons thirty
dollars to be paid out of the price of a negro hereafter
mentioned.

I give to my grand son William Scott one bed
and furniture.

I give to my son John Martin and to my daughter
Martha Haskins a negro woman named Letha and my
will and desire is that she should be treated well as she
hath been a good slave to me.

344 I give to my two daughters Martha Haskins and
Letha Semons ten dollars each to be paid out of the price
of a negro woman named Hannah which I desire should
be sold to the highest bidder and also my desk and cup-
board also my horse and farming tools my hogs and sheep
and all my cattle except one cow.
I give my will and desire is that after the money of
sale of the above mentioned articles is collected and all
my just debts is paid and Legacies above mentioned that
the balance remaining should be at the disposal of my
executors or interest for the benefit of my son Amos &
Leis. until they come of age and then to be equally
divided between them all.

I give to my negro woman named Hannah one cow
Lastly I appoint John Read and Thomas Hopkins
executors of this my last will and testament hereby
revoking all others heretofore made in witness where-
of I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
this the third day of December one thousand eight
hundred and thirteen.
