Now in the first one thousand eight hundred and two
In the name of God Amen I Zachariah Wall of
the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina
being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thank
be God and calling to mind the mortality of my body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
that is to say principally and first of all I give and
recommend my soul unto Almighty God that great
and my body to be buried in a Christian like manner
at the discretion of my executors hereafter named with
my according but to receive it again by the mighty
power of God at the general resurrection and as to
disposing such worldly estate where with it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life I give devise and appoint
of the same in the following manner and foremost
I leave to my beloved wife Ann during her natural
life or widowhood all my estate both real and
personal and after the death or marriage of my wife
it is my desire that an equal division shall take
place among all of my children or their heirs if it is

it is also my will and desire that as any of my children
should die leaving no heirs that their part of my estate
should be equally divided among the rest of the children
then or their heirs and as it is my will and desire to do
equal right Justice with all my children after the
death or marriage of my wife it is my will for all my
estate of every kind to be divided equally among my
children with this reserve only that that those of my chil-
dren who have already received part of my estate
to receive any more until the rest have received equal
sums with them then an equal share for division
is my will and for a guide for my executors will
here make a charge against my children who have
had a part of my estate before
my daughter Amy hath had to the amount \$ 8
my son Robert hath had 6 12 6
my son Richard hath had 13 13 0
my daughter Ann hath had 7 2 10 0
my daughter Elizabeth hath had 5 9 4
my daughter Sarah hath had 6 5 0
my daughter Sarah hath had 8 15 0
which sums are all in Virginia currency
Lastly I appoint my beloved sons Richard Wall
and Robert Wall executors of this my last will and
testament reserving all former wills by me made
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this first day of November Eighteen hundred
and two legible sealed published and declared
the said Zachariah Wall as his last will and
testament in the presence of us who in his presence
and the presence of each other have honest witness

In the name of God. Amen I William Garrison of the
County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina being
of sound perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) do this
sixth day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred
and twenty six make and publish this my last Will
and testament in manner following that is to say First
I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Garrison all that
tract of land wherein I now live Except that of the same that I do herein
after dispose of to my friend Human Giles together with all the crop that
I may die possessed of and all the house held and Kitchen Furniture
plantation Utensils of every description together with all my Stock
of every description consisting of thorough cattle sheep hogs &c.
to her free from all Incumbrances whatever forever

I give and bequeath unto my son John Garrison six Negroes
namely, Abraham, William, Raufude, Isaac, David, to him or
his heirs forever.

I give and bequeath to each of my Sons Namely William
Zachariah Starling & Leander one dollar each to be paid by
my executor to them & their heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my trusty friend Thomas Giles the
following piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County
and State of said adjoining the the lands of Thomas Giles are

bounded as followeth Beginning at said Giles comes on the Creek ⁽³²⁴⁾
down the Creek as it Meanders to the rod and line thence along his
line to Mr. Moreheads line thence along his line to Thos Giles line
thence along his line to the Beginning and containing fifty acres
be the same more or less also the three following Negroes namely
Isaac Agger child Thomas to him and his heirs forever
And I do hereby make certain my Executors of this my
last Will and Testament let my last Will and Testament
here to this my last Will and testament set my hand
signed sealed published and
declared by me said William ^{his} ^{Executor} ^{Seal}
Garrison

as his last
