Now for the first one thousand eight hundred & two
 In the name of God Amen I Zachariah Wall of
 the County of Rockingham and State of North Carolina
 being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thank
 be to God and calling to mind the mortality of my body
 and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
 that is to say principally and first of all I give and
 recommend my soul unto Almighty God that gave it
 and my body to be buried in a christian like manner
 at the discretion of my executors hereafter named
 nothing doubting but to receive it again by the mighty
 power of God at the General resurrection and as to
 the things such worldly estate where with it hath pleased
 God to bless me in this life I give devise and assign
 of the same in the following manner and form first
 I leave to my beloved wife Ann during her natural
 life or in a word her whole all my estate both real and
 personal and after the death or marriage of my wife
 it is my desire that an equal division should take
 place among all of my children or their heirs it is

it is also my will and desire that as any of my children
 should die leaving no heirs that their part of my estate
 should be equally divided among the rest of my children
 then or their heirs and as it is my will and desire to do
 equal right Justice with all my children after the
 death or marriage of my wife it is my will for all my
 estate of every kind to be divided equally among my
 children with this reason only that that those of my children
 who have already received a part of my estate
 to receive any more until the rest have received equal
 sums with them then an equal and fair division
 is my will and for a guide for my executors I will
 here make a charge against my children who have
 had a part of my estate here before

 and twenty six make and publish this my last Will
 and testament in manner following that is to say First
 I give and bequeath unto My beloved Wife Mary Harrison all that
~~part~~ of land whereon I now live Except that of the same that I do hereinafter
 after dispose of to my Friend Thomas Siles together with all the crop that
 I may die possessed of and all the House hold and Kitchen Furniture
 plantation Utensils of Every description together with all my stock
 of Every description consisting of Horses cattle sheep Hogs &c.
 to her free from all Incumbrances Whatever forever

I give and bequeath unto my son John Harrison Six Negroes
 namely, Abraham, William, Mary, Jude, Isaac David, to him and
 his heirs forever

I give and bequeath to Each of My Sons Namely William
 Zacheariah Starling & Leonard one dollar each to be paid by
 my executor to them & their heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my trusty friend Thomas Siles the
 following piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County
 and State of aforesaid adjoining the land of Thomas Siles own

bounded as followeth Beginning at said Siles comes on the Creek then
 down the Creek as it Meanders to Bradnaces line thence along his
 line to Mrs. Moreheads line thence along his line to this Siles line
 thence along his line to the Beginning and containing fifty acres
 be the same more or less also the three following Negroes namely
 Isaac Aggy & child Thomas to him and his heirs forever
 And I do hereby make and publish my last Will and testament
 out. In Witness Whereof I the said William Harrison
 have to this my last Will and testament set my hand
 and seal the day and year above written.
 Signed sealed published and
 declared by the said William Harrison
 as his last
 Will and testament in the presence
 of us who were present at the time
 of signing and sealing thereof
