

Zadoc Griffith.

In the name of God the Father
I Zadoc Griffith of the County of Rockingham
and State of North Carolina being sick and weak of
body but of a strong mind and disposing memory
do this 36th day of April in the year of our Lord one
1821 make and publish this my last will and
testament hereby revoking and making void all
former wills made by me made.

I do chearfully resign my soul to God my Saviour
and my body to be buried at the discretion of my
surviving friends and as for what world goods it
hath pleased God to bless me with I give and bequeath
in the following manner —
I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary
the tract of land that I now live on containing 180-
acres together with all my stock of hogs cows sheep
hogs house hold and kitchen furniture except what I
shall hereafter name to her enduring her natural life
and after her death it is my will that this tract
of land shall go to my son William Griffith to
him and his heirs forever and it is my will and
pleasure the tract of land that I bought of James et al.
one of 318 acres be equally divided between my two
sons James Griffith and Anderson Griffith to them and
their heirs forever. I give to my son Joseph Griffith
my blacksmith tools of every kind to him and

his heirs forever. I give to my daughter Sally Griffith about
so much and and bride to be worth one hundred dollars
together with a good feather bed and furniture to her
and her heirs forever also a black mahogany chest.
My waggon and gear I leave to my wife Mary Griffith
enduring her natural life and I give her power to sell
any property or stock that she thinks she do not stand
in need of to support her self and her children and it
is my will and pleasure that after the death of my wife
Mary that what hereafter is remaining be equally divided
among my five children (Viz) James Sally Anderson
Joseph and William.

I appoint and ordain my wife Mary Griffith and my
son James Griffith and Thomas Mullas Executors of this my
last will and Testament in testimony I have hereunto set
my hand and annex my seal this day and date above
written signed sealed and delivered
in the presence of us.
