Will and I do order my beloved wife the other third  
part of my movable Estate during her widow-  
hood, if she Marries her horse Saddle Bed and  
furniture & the wrench box and no more -  
Item it is my will and I do order my son Benedict  
the Eastern side of my Plantation divided by  
North and South line as as not to touch any  
of my Improvements at the Barn, Item it  
is my will & as to be ordered at my Wifes death  
all her part or portion of my Estate to be equally di-  
vided among or between My boys Benedict & John  
Disallowing all other former wills Legacies or  
Executors, ordering and allowing by the present  
my beloved friend Lewis Tilton & Mr. Brown  
Junior to be my joint Executors of this my  
last Will and Testament, And I further do  
order if my Negroes above willed do not  
behave themselves in obedience to their Masters
