I Adam Sprack Senr of Rowan County in the State of North Carolina, Planter, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, thanks be given to God, do make and ordain this my last will and testament. To wit First of all I recommend my soul into the hands of my dear Lord Jesus Christ who gave it, and my Body to be buried in the united Brethrens burying ground at Friedberg. And as touching my worldly Estate, I give and bequeath the same in the manner following, to wit.

1. I give & bequeath unto my dear son Gottlieb Sprack Twenty five Dollars lawfull money of the United States, and unto my dear son Jacob Sprack Twenty five Dollars six money and unto my deceased daughters Marys Children Christiana Gerner, the wife of Joseph Gerner and Gottlieb Maria Kernes Spinster to each of them One Dollar six money.

2. I give and bequeath all the remainder of my personal estate to my dear sons Adam, John, Gottlieb, Jacob, Joseph, and to my dear daughters Rosina, Mary Elizabeth & Anna Johana to be divided among them share & share alike, according to the appraisement of my moveable goods by two indifferent men appointed by my Executors, together with any notes, bonds or money I may die possessed of.

3. I do hereby make, ordain constitute & appoint my said dear son Gottlieb Sprack of Stokes County and my beloved friend Lazarus Mege of Rowan County, executors of this my last will & test jointly & severally, and do hereby disannul & make void all my former wills or legacies by me done either in writing or by word of mouth, ratifying & confirming these present and no other to be my last will & Test.
