Likewise I give & bequeath unto my son David White one negro boy named Vines; likewise I give & bequeath unto my son Will^m White one negro boy named Sampson. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Dean Templeton eight shillings. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my son John White eight shillings, likewise I give & bequeath unto my son James White eight shillings. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Red eight shillings. Likewise, I give & bequeath unto my Mary McCow eight shillings - likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Wilson eight shilling. The remainder part of my estate moveable estate I allow for the rearing & maintaining of the widow & my children & to portion them off when they may need it at the discretion of their mother & the other executors. 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I intend to be sold & the money arising from the same to be equally divided between Penelope Eleanor & Margaret White, likewise I allow my daughter Cathrina Red an equal divide of the price above mentioned two negroes. Thus I make & ordain constitute my well beloved wife Eleanor White & David & James White my sons to be my sole ex^{ors}. of this my last will & testament & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former will & test. legacies, bequeaths & executors by me in any way before named written & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test.
