as the remainder of my estate herein before
is directed — And I also hereby declare and
pronounce this to be part of last Will & Testa-
ment in addition to what was signed and
sealed yesterday in as full and ample a
Manner as if it had been inserted before the
last was signed Recreated. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
Seal the 11th day of December in the year of our
Lord 1788. Signed sealed published & pronounced

mortality that it is appointed for all men once to die have thought

plantation with all the appurtenances there unto
belonging and Thirdly I do bequeath to my beloved
Alexander Carruth Son of Robert Carruth ten Shillings
Sterling as a memorandum of my affection and favoritely
I do will and bequeath to my honored Mother & all
the rest of my Estate Goods and Chattels to her to dispose
of as she shall think proper and this I declare to be
my Last will and Testament signed sealed published
