advantage of my negro woman slave named
Cloe so long as she remains a widow for the
purpose of enabling her to raise & support
her children, but in case she marries it is
my direction that Cloe be given up to my
~~children~~ Executors to be disposed of by them
as the remainder of my estate herein before
is directed - And I also hereby declare and
pronounced this to be part of last will & testa-
ment in addition to what was signed and
Sealed yesterday in as full and ample a
manner as if it had been intended before the
last was signed & executed. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
Seal the 14th day of December in the year of our
Lord 1788. Signed sealed published & pronounced
as part of the aforesaid will by this J. B. and in the
presence of us John Brown & others

In the name of God Amen I Alexander Caruth of
Rowan County in the state of North Carolina being sick & weak
in body but sound in mind & memory & calling to mind ^{my} ~~the~~
mortality that it is appointed for all men once to die have thought
fit to make the following regulation of my affairs - and first of
all I commit my soul to God who gave it & my body to the earth
to be buried in a decent manner at the expense of my Executors &
for that I appoint my honored Mother & John Dickey to see this
my last will & testament executed & as for such worldly estate as God
hath been pleased to bless me with I do bequeath in manner & form as
followeth & first of all I order my just debts to be paid out of my Es-
tate Secondly I do Bequeath to my well beloved Nephew
John McCulluck Son of William McCulluck my
plantation with all the appurtenances there unto
belonging and Thirdly I do bequeath to my Nephew
Alexander Caruth Son of Robert Caruth ten shilling
Shilling as a memorandum of my affection and fourthly
I do will and bequeath to my honored Mother & all
the rest of my Estate Goods and Chattles to her to dispose
of as she shall think proper and this I declare to be
my Last will and Testament signed sealed published
pronounced and declared in presence of us
