Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty eight I Andrew  
McKee of the Parish of Saint Luke in the County of Rowan and  
Province of North Carolina blacksmith being very weak weak in  
Body but of perfect Mind & memory Thanks be given to God therefore  
calling to mind the Mortality of my  
Body knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die and  
afterward the Judgment do make & ordain this my last Will & Testa-  
ment first of principally of all I give & bequeath my soul into  
the Hand of God who gave it and my Body I command it to the  
Earth to be buried in a Christian Manner at the Discretion of my  
Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I  
shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as  
touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless  
me with in this Life I give & devise & dispose of in the following  
Manner and Form viz: Imprimis It is my Will and pleasure  
that all my lawfull Debts and funeral Charges be paid before  
any Division be made. Item I nominate constitute & appoint  
my dearly beloved Wife Jane and my Brother John McKee  
Executors of this my last Will & Testament, as is here bequeathed.  
I give & bequeath to Jane my dearly beloved Wife a gray man  
named Hagg of her choice before any Division be made. After-  
wards her equal share of my movable Estate with my Children  
both males & females, and also it my Will & pleasure that my de-  
loved Wife have the use of plantation to her use & the childrens  
during her life & that my Children may be well schooled  
at the Discretion of my Executors. I give & bequeath unto my beloved  
sons John & Andrew the place wherone I now dwell to be equally divided  
between them when Andrew comes to age of twenty one Years, to them  
their Heirs & assigns forever. I give & bequeath to my well beloved child-  
ren wife Mary, Jane, John, Andrew, Margaret, to be or be whom my Wife is  
now with Child all having an equal share of my personal Estate to them  
their Heirs & assigns forever except what is above bequeathed to my wife  
and her assigns.

that is to say principally first of all I give & command my soul into  
the Hands of God that gave it & for my body I command it to the Earth  
to be buried in a Christian like Manner at the Discretion of my Executor  
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive  
the same again by the almighty power of God and as touching such  
worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this  
Life with I give devise and dispose of the same in the following man-  
ner & Form that is to say First I do give & bequeath  
to my loving Wife one third part of my movable Estate which is to  
be paid her by my Executors Executrix. Secondly I do give & bequeath  
to my four Daughters Margaret Jane Eliz. & Ann six Pounds  
Pennsylvania Money when of the Age of eighteen and if any of them  
should die before that Age her other shares to be equally divided be-  
tween the survivors. Thirdly I do give & bequeath to my son John  
Twenty pounds like Money but if he should die before he is of the  
Age of twenty this shall not be paid. Fourthly I do give & bequeath  
to my son John an equal part with my son James in all  
the Year of his life which is now John own Property  
as is under my loan by purchase of his own. Fifthly I do give  
& bequeath to my son James an equal part with John  
constitute appoint make & ordain him my sole Exec-  
utor to my last Will and Testament & all singular things  
left to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever, and I

Province of North Carolina Yeoman. Being through the abundant  
Grace and Goodness of God, though weak in Body yet of a  
sound & perfect Understanding and Memory do constitute this my  
last Will & Testament and now it may be recorded by all as such.  
First I most humbly bequeath my Soul to God my Maker, before whom  
I most Acquiesced of it, through the all sufficient Merit &  
Mediation of my most compassionate Redemer Jesus Christ, who  
gave himself to be an Atonement for my sins, and is able to save to  
the uttermost, all that cometh to him by him, saving his own life to make  
intercession for them, and who I trust will not reject me, returning  
at dinner when I come to him for Mercy; in this hope and  
trust I render up my soul with comfort humbly beseeching the  
Blessed Everlasting Trinity, one God, most holy, most judicious &  
wise to prepare me for the time of my dissolution, and to take  
me with into that peaceful Rest, and incomparable Joy which  
is prepared for all that love & fear his holy Name. When I yield  
my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken in  
full expectation of its Resurrection from thence at the coming As

111) manage it with all requisite Prudence. As to my worldly Estate I will  
and positively order, that all my Debts to be paid first I give & bequeath  
unto my dear & loving Wife Mary Myers a Plantation in Hertford  
County (which I had by purchase from George King George the Second) to her her  
Life Time together with Furniture and other Conveniences requisite for her  
on P. place. Likewise a Plantation called the New Branch neare her Life Time  
together with all Conveniences belonging thereto. Likewise half the planta-  
tion I now live on in Person County with the half of the Profit of the same  
that is thereon together with all my movable Estate to carry the bringing  
up of my children and the movable Estate shall be at her own disposal to  
what she will therewith. Item I give & bequeath to Henry Dohad Jr. and  
two hundred Acres of Land lying & being in Hertford County to  
his Heirs & Assigns forever, but so as the said Henry Dohad shall not  
or dispose of the Land without the consent of his wife Elizabeth Dohad  
formerly Eliz. Myers. Item I give & bequeath my daughter Barbara Myers  
one two hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land it being the last End of an  
125 acre tract of Land lying and being on the South Side of P. D. in Her-  
tford County to her & her Heirs & Assigns forever after her death  
Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Myers two hundred acres  
Land the last End of the 125 acre tract of Land in Hertford County ap-  
to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. Item I give & bequeath my son Michael  
Myers two hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land part of the Plantation  
where I now live together with all the Appurtenances thereto belonging  
after the Death of his Mother, and till her Death to have but half the  
Profit of such Plantation to him his Heirs & Assigns forever.  
Item I give & bequeath untoannah Myers one hundred & Seven  
the remaining part of the Plantation where I now live on the  
corner on a branch called Millers Branch to her her Heirs & Assigns  
forever. Item I give & bequeath unto John Blacksticker and his  
Myers a tract of Land called the New Branch neare after the Death of his  
Mother to be equally to be divided between them their Heirs &
