On the Name of God, Amen I Am Thomas of the Province of North Carolina in Rowan County being very sick & low in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory thank be to God calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and that it is appointed of all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that gave it my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God: and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I give demise and dispose of in the following Manner First I give and bequeath to my son John Dills one Shilling current money of Great Britain. Also the Plantation or Tract of Land of the said Ann Thomas now lies on I give and bequeath to my Grandson, the Ado son of Peter Dill also one red Kine cow Calf. Also I give to Peter Dills the youngest son of Peter Dills one Brown heifer Cow with her Calf. Also I give to Mary York my Daughter to Peter Dills one Duffel Blanket, also I have all my Stock and Household stuff and my movable Estate except the things already given to be left by John Yorkly and Harry Dills whom to make and constitute and remain the sole sole Executors of my last Will & Testament and after paying all my lawfull debts the remainder to be divided equally amongst my Grand Children Ann Dills, Abigail and Peter Dills who I command to be left to God freely purified of injuries. And I do hereby testify before God to have remand all and every other person to his and my undivided Legacy to my Grand Children by me as my Executor and

First I will that my funeral Charges and all other my just Debts to be first paid by Money raised out of my Estate. - Secondly I give & bequeath to Margaret my dearly beloved Wife the old Duck House and the Stag Man and his gray Lot I give and bequeath my beloved Wife Margaret and to my son John and to my son Joseph my Plantation whereon I now live each of them to have an equal share thereof to them and their Heirs and the above named Duck House the old Stag Man & his gray Lot to be & remain for the use of the Plantation and the same to be left to my son Joseph for his use as for my wife Margaret Thirdly
