In the name of God Amen! I *Palsor* Duttraw
of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina. This day being
weak of body - but of sound mind & memory & dispoital. Thanks
be to God for his mercie & calling to mind the mortality of
the body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die &
after death to judgment. I resigne myself up to God
And as touching my worldly goods, as it had pleased God to
blef me with in this life I do on this 22nd day of February
1801 give devise & dispose of in manner & form following
that is to say. First I give & bequeath to my dearly beloved
son Jacob Duttraw one hundred & ninety acres of land to
include my dwelling plantation, whereon I now live to
him his heirs & assigns forever & 2. I give & bequeath
to my son David Duttraw one hundred & seventy nine
acres of land, composed of the following pieces of land &
to be layd off in the following manner (viz) fifty acres
of this my original tract & forty acres taken up by
me as surplus land & thirty nine acres I bought of
John Adams & fifty acres I bought of Richard Leach
all of which land to be laid off in the following mannes
beginning on Lathans line & runs a straight line to
Marked Poplar - I made for this devise & then runs a

west course to the surplus forty acres, & in case it does not
had out measure to make the above quantity of one hundred
& seventy nine acres the west line from the Poplar must
not extend so far as the surplus, so of the quantity be in-
cluded, all this I give to him, the said David Duttraw his
heirs & assigns forever. 3. My will & desire is that all my
personal estate except plantation tools shall be appraised
by three men chosen by my executors & such estate to be
equally divided between my beloved wife Elizabeth Duttraw
& my two young daughters Catharina Duttraw & Barbara
Duttraw so as each of them have a equal share - & my wife
Elizabeth to have her living & residue at this my dwelling
house during her continuancy as my widow & when
the true appraisement is accertained of my personal estate
divided as above, it is my express will & intention, that
my son Jacob Duttraw, who have this my dwelling plan-
tation to pay to my daughter Elizabeth Duttraw as
much money at the age of eighteen years as the appraised
value of either of my other daughters share. And also all
the plantation & carpenters tools, to be equally divided
between my two sons Jacob & David in the like mannes
as above & no other part of my personal estate. And
lastly I do hereby constitute, ordain, & appoint my
wife Elizabeth Duttraw, & my son Jacob Duttraw my
whole & sole executors to this my last will & testament
revoking & making void all wills & bequaths, heretofore

by me made, ratifying & confirming this & no other to
be my last will & test:

In the name of God Amen! I Mary Dowthit
of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina, am weak in body
but in perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God for his
mercies & calling to mind the mortality of my body & that
is appointed for all once to die, do make & ordain this my last
will & test. Principally & first of all I give my soul to God
who gave it me & my body to the earth, to be buried in a
christian like manner at the discretion of my ~~executors~~
friends, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God
& as touching my worldly goods, I give & dispose of as followeth.
I will & bequeath to my son Abraham Dowthit one feather
bed & furniture & as much out of my stock or household goods
as will amount to fifteen pounds besides the bed.

I will & bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Hill one
Negro girl named Hannah. I will that my wearing appo-
rel be equally divided between my daughters. I will & bequeath
unto my granddaughter Rebecca Dowthit, daughter to
Thomas my saddle. I will & bequeath unto my son Jacob
Dowthit the remaining part of my whole estate in stock

& household, goods & also all debt due to me
I do constitute & ordain my son Jacob Dowthit executor of
this my last will & test: & I do disannull & make void all
other wills & bequeaths by me made or done, ratifying &
confirming this & no other to be my last will & test. In wit-
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 27
day of February 1790.

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Dickey
of Rowan County in N. Carolina, being afflicted in body but
perfectly sound in mind & memory, knowing that it is ap-
pointed for all men once to die; It is therefore my wish & di-
rection, that the property wherewith it had pleased to bless
me to be disposed of in the following way & manner (viz)

- 1/ I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Eleanor Dickey my
mansion house & all household furniture thereto belonging,
also all stocks of migne horses, cows, sheeps & hogs, to be her
& at her own disposal forever; further all my negro servants
now about me, in like manner to be disposed of by her as
her own property; all farming tools belonging to the plantation.
- 2/ I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Anderson one
Negro girl named Tide now in her possession.
- 3/ I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane Rosbrough one
Negro girl named Sal now in her possession.
- 4/ I give & bequeath to my son John Dickey the plantation
