At this will that my son Moses have the use of the house & improvements on which he now lives together with what land of his own he has on the side of the creek with the one half on the plantation on which he now lives in witness whereof I have signed this instrument this day in the month of December anno domini一千七百九十二年

liberty to clear his <sup>new</sup> & cultivate the same on the side of the river  
on which I now live for the term of ten years & no longer in  
paying the tax of the lands above during the term of ten years  
that he has them in his <sup>possession</sup> & at the expiration of ten years from  
the date thereof the <sup>then</sup> improvements & lands aforesaid to be  
disposed of as hereafter directed. Also I will that my wife Alice  
have the right proportion & use of the non-inheriting part of my estate  
real & personal until my son Benjamin comes of age at which time  
I will that my whole estate of said real & personal distributed between  
my wife Alice, my son Benjamin, & my daughter Sarah in such manner  
as the act of Assembly directs respecting intercalate Estates. And lastly  
I do hereby constitute & appoint my brother William Noland  
and my brother in law John Gathay executors in trust of this  
my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have here-

& in the county of Rowan being weak & low of body but of a sound mind  
memory & desirous thanks be to Almighty God for his mercies. I calling to mind  
the mortality of the body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die & after death  
to come to judgment. I do on this first day of November in the year of our Lord 1790 pub-  
lish this my last will and testament first of all giving my soul to God through his Son  
Jesus Christ & my body to be decently buried upon the earth in a Christian like  
manner at the discretion of my executors hoping to hear them again united together  
at the great & general resurrection by the mighty power of God & as touching ~~all~~  
worldly goods as it pleases almighty God to bless me with in this life I give and  
dispose of in this manner that is to say first I give unto my beloved wife  
Mary Noland 74 acres of Land to be laid off where I now live including the  
dwelling & plantation as far as the main branch between the ~~two~~ two sides  
to her heirs & assigns forever and also I give to her my several more  
years & a black man & eight head of stock (all my cattle)  
beds & furniture to her & her heirs for ever 2<sup>d</sup> I give to my son  
Stephen Noland my several colt & my youngest bridle horse (him)  
his heirs forever. 3<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my son Liseton Noland my  
saddle & the black colt he paying to my son James Noland one half there-  
of and colt which colt to be valued by two men at three years old  
4<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my granddaughter Anna Gathay for her use & the child  
to be delivered my daughter Anna Gathay for the use of the child  
immediately after my decease. 5<sup>d</sup> I give & bequeath to my wife Mary  
Noland all the rest of my stock of cattle to her use & giving to my  
son Liseton Noland James Albie Mary & Eleanor Noland my children  
as they may grow up. & also I give to my wife as above  
all the rest of my household furniture of every kind & man-
