Kinder of the Town of Salisbury Hatter being very
sick but of sound mind and memory, and knowing
that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make
this my last Will and Testament, that is to say
Principally and first of all, I do command my
soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it nothing
doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall re-
ceive the same again by the mighty power of God
and my body I do command to the Earth to be buried
in a decent Christian Burial, at the discretion

of my Executors hereafter named and as to my real
Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with
in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner and form, that is to say, first I
do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty good friends
Peter Ward, and Thomas Troxell my whole and able
Executors. Second my will is that all my funeral charges
and just debts be first paid out of my Estate, Third
I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife Anna
Savannah Kinder during her widowhood the use of my
dwelling house and houses, Kitchen and garden in the
Town of Salisbury the Hatter shop only excepted and my
Plantation I also give to my said dearly beloved
Wife during her life, One feather Bed and furniture
One big Bay Mare and Saddle and Bridle One Cow
and Calf and the one third part of my Estate law the
care of my dearly beloved Daughter Betsy and my
Youngest Sons John and Jacob until they may be
fit to put to trade by my Executors, fourth, my Will
is that at the Marriage or death of my dearly beloved
Wife - Then it is my will and desire that all my
said dwelling House Out houses Kitchen and garden
to the toll whereon they stand in the Town of
Salisbury and my plantation near the same
shall be sold by my said Executors, who are

hurby invested with full power to execute a Deed for
the same, and the money arising from such Sale to
be equally Divided among my dearly beloved Child-
ren share and share alike and the money put
to Interest on good Security Renewable yearly &
paid to each of my said Children as they may com-
e of age fifth my will is that my said Executors are
hurby invested with full power and authority to
Bind and put to good Use as soon as they may
be fit for the same my dearly beloved sons, George
Casper, Jacob and John - and my desire is that if
Christian Throat should think proper to take my
dearly beloved Son George Apprentice and learn him
the art and Mystery of a Hatter he the said Throat
may have the use of my Shop and the Articles there-
unto belonging, with this proviso that he take my
said Son under his care and give him and Security
for the safe keeping and delivering all in good Repair
as he may receive them at the time my said Son George
shall come of age of Twenty one Years, and my des-
ire is that on Christian Throat complying with
the above Request my Executors are hereby desired
not to make sale of the Hatters shop or any thing
thereunto belonging until my said Son George
shall come to his full age of Twenty One
