Salisbury Oct. 1st 1785
In the name of God Amen, I, Casper Kinder of the Town of Salisbury Hatter being very sick but of sound mind and memory, and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make this my last Will and Testament, that is to say principally and first of all, I do recommend my soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial, at the discretion

195 of my Executors hereafter named and as to my worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form, that is to say, first I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty good friends Lewis Beard, and Thomas Trobach my Whole and Sole Executors. Second my will is that all my funeral charges and just debts be first paid out of my Estate, Third I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife Anna Susannah Kinder during her Widowhood the use of my dwelling house out houses, Kitchen and garden in the Town of Salisbury the Hatter Shop only excepted and my Plantation I also give to my said dearly beloved Wife during her life, One feather Bed and furniture One big Bay Mare and saddle and Bridle One Cow and Calf and the one third part of my Estate I am the care of my dearly beloved Daughter Betsey and my Youngest Sons John and Jacob untill they may be fit to put to trade by my Executors, fourth, my Will is that at the Marriage or death of my dearly beloved Wife - Then it is my will and desire that all my said dwelling House Out houses Kitchen and garden with the toll wherupon they stand in the Town of Salisbury and my Plantation near the same shall be sold by my said Executors, who are

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hereby invested with full power to execute a Quid for
the same, and the money arising from such sale to
be equally divided among my dearly beloved Chil-
dren share and share alike and the money put
to Interest on good Security Renewable Yearly &
paid to each of my said Children as they may come
of age fifth my will is that my said Executors are
hereby invested with full power and authority to
Bind and put to good Trade as soon as they may
be fit for the same my dearly beloved sons, George
Casper, Jacob and John - and my desire is that if
Christian Throat should think proper to take my
dearly beloved Son George Apprentice and learn him
the art and Mystery of a Hatter he the said Throat
may have the use of my Shop and the Articles there-
unto belonging, with this proviso that he take my
said Son under his care and give Bond and Security
for the safe keeping and delivering all in good Repair
as he may receive them at the time my said Son George
shall come of age of Twenty one Years, and my de-
sire is that on Christian Throat complying with
the above Request my Executors are hereby desired
not to make sale of the Hatters shop or any thing
thereunto belonging until my said Son George
shall come to his full age of Twenty One

Years; lastly, I the said Casper Kindar do hereby
thoroughly revoke disannull, and make void any
other former Will and Testament by me hereto-
fore made Ratifying and confirming this and
no other to be my last Will and Testament in Tes-
timony whereof I the said Casper Kindar have
hereunto set my hand and seal the day and
Year first above written, signed sealed published
and pronounced and declared by the said Casper
Kindar to be his last Will and Testament in the
Presence of us who in his presence have hereunto
subscribed our names and in the presence of each
other, N.B. the words and my attestation and during
his Widowhood was entered before signed
