Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Lyon one negroe girl named Nan - one bed & furniture, saddle & cloak & no more to her & her heirs & assigns forever.

Lastly I name constitute & ordain my loving wife & my son Richard Lyon executors of this my last will & test: hereby revoking & disannulling all former wills & test: be-
queathments, devises & legacies & executors by me in any manner of ways before this time made, ratifying this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the year & day above written -

Also I do give unto my beloved wife one saddle & bridle, which she chooses also, two cows three sheeps, two barrows upwards of a year old four shoats, also two beds with the furniture, & of the household furniture what she at her discretion please to take & at her decease all the above mentioned articles to be sold & the money to be disposed of as it is hereunder directed.

And as touching my daughter Sarah Hendricks she has already had a full share or competence of this my estate, therefore I do not allow her any more. I do & appoint & ordain that all the rest of my estate be sold both real & personal except what is already mentioned & all my just debts to be paid & what

is left, after paying my debts to residue to descend to my son Daniel Lewis & my daughter Curingham, two part to my son Daniel the other to my daughter Hannah. I do appoint that at my wife's decease the above mentioned fifty acres of land shall descend to my son Daniel Lewis. I do appoint that my beloved wife shall have a sufficient support of the crops that is now in the ground & of that which will be put in this next spring so that she may be amply supported until the May 1802. I do appoint & ordain that my beloved wife & my son Daniel Lewis be the sole executors of this my last will & test & I do hereby revoke & disannul all & every other legacies wills & testaments, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 19th day of March 1801.
