 strawberry house branched on the near shoulder this 17th
 instant of my life, I allow my brother Leonard Boyd one
 to divide equally among all my brothers & sisters keep
 to himself an equal part only my eldest brother
 Jacob if he dont sign a deed for 120 acres of land which I
 bought of my father & has administrator is to make no
 of so land he is to have no part of the rest but if he
 complys with my fathers bargain & signs the deed
 without trouble or fate he is to have an equal part with
 me in all whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
 seal this 22nd day of October 1790

 she remains my widow & if she marrie I do hereby allow
 my executors to put sale my plantation to the best advantage
 until my thousands is of age and then to be equally divided
 amongst them. Secondly I do will & bequeath unto my wife
 christina one bed & bedding. Thirdly I do will & bequeath the
 all the remainder of my moveable property to be vendid & sold
 and that my wife christina to have & to hold one third part of my
 estate & the remainder to be equally divided among my children
 Fourthly I do hereby appoint Col. John Lopp & Phillip Linard
 executors of this my last will & testament Signed &
 delivered in the presence of us this 22nd day of october
 1790
