be therefore given to God. I do hereby make & ordain this
my last will & test in manner & form following, that is
to say first & principally I recommend my soul into the
hands of the almighty God, hoping through the merits
of my blessed saviour Jesus Christ have fully & free pardon,
& forgiveness of all my sins & to inherit everlasting life
And my body I comit to the earth to be decently buried at
the discretion of my executors hereafter named & as touch
the disposition of all such temporal estate as it had
pleased God to bestow upon me I give & dispose of as
followed.

First I will that all my debts & funeral charges
shall be paid & discharged.

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Daniel
Mock one hundred & ninety five acres of land with my

homestead plantation & all the improvements thereon &
the said quantity of land as above to be laid off in as
suitable a manner as possible, joining the old plantation
& that my ^{dear} beloved son Daniel Mock shall by my
desire with & last test: allow his honoured Mother Phebe
Mock enduring her life time free privilege of the home
stead house & premises, where she now lives & that my son
Daniel Mock shall give his honoured Mother fifty
bushels of wheat & fifty bushels of corn & two hundred
weight of pork yearly & also give my beloved wife
Phebe Mock one brown Mare, bridle & side saddle & one
negro boy slave by the name of Liser & one Negro girl by
the name of Mago two feather beds & furniture one
spinning wheel, one Iron pot one Dutch oven, one washing
pot & one hundred pounds hard money to be recovered of
the vendue money & also two Cows & calves & that my
son shall feed the stock that I have willed to his ho
noured mother, free gratis enduring her life time or widoa
hood, which Negro boy Liser that I have left to my
beloved wife enduring her lifetime my will & desire is
that my son Daniel Mock shall have him as his own
property at her death & all the above mentioned article
that is mentioned in Daniel Mocks name to him &
his heirs & assigns for ever.

And what is given as above mentioned to my beloved
wife all but the negro boy Liser which is only for
her life time or widowhood. I give & bequeath to my
beloved son Daniel Mock to him & his heirs forever.

56 Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved son John Mock one hundred & ninety five acres of land lying on the North end of my lot, of land one bay horse four years old by name of Tarlton one plough & ploughs & trone with gears suitable & one ax & mattock to him & his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Mary Coppage one hundred acres of land lying on the west end of my lot of land where I now reside on & ten pounds hard money when the vendue money is collected to her & her heirs forever.

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved daughter Catharina Houck Sixty five pounds hard money after the vendue money is collected to her & her heirs forever. My will & desire is that all the rest & residue of my estate ungiven shall be sold & equally divided between my two sons & two daughters, which is Daniel Mock John Mock, Mary Coppage & Catharina Houck & all of them to share & share equally alike of the vendue money after they collected. I also appoint my beloved friend Jacob Clinard, & my beloved wife Phebe Mock executory of this my last will & test. & I do hereby utterly disavow revoke & disannul all & every other former test. by me in any way made, named & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this to be no other to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal. 19th Day of Feb. 1798.

First I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent & Christian like manner & as touching such worldly concerns as it had pleased God to bless me with in this life I bequeath in following manner.

First I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Elizabeth McNelly her mare & colts saddle & bridle all my household furniture all my stock of cattle & hogs, sheeps, etc. during her natural life then my moveable property to be equally divided between my daughters Mary Elizabeth, Martha & Ann McNelly. I give & bequeath unto my loving & dutiful children James McNelly Archibald, Robert & Isaac McNelly - my daughter Eleanor McNelly ten shillings each to be paid out of my moveable property by my executors.

I give unto my daughter Margaret Miller ten shillings I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary McNelly all the property she now claims as her own right & my good sonal maid.

I give & bequeath unto my sons John McNelly & Samuel McNelly the land whereon I now live & that they pay unto my daughter Eleanor McNelly ten pounds & that she support the family out of said farm as long as she live together or rather during the life of my wife Elizabeth if she
