And as touching such worldly estate whereof it had

Item I give & bequeath to my loving wife Mary a feather bed & furniture, what puter in the house, two Iron pots, her choice of all my horses, or mares, & her saddle, spinning wheel two cows, her own bible, all her wearing apparels for ever. The plantation I live on while she continues my widow & shall clothe & support my children.

Item I give & demise, to my three sons James, Henry & Samuel the plantation whereon I now live to be equally divided amongst them & their heirs & assigns for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my three sons James, Henry, & Samuel & to my two daughters, Mary & Ann, my share of Land to be divided by my executors, & by them sold, together with all the remainder of my personal estate, & equally divided amongst them share & share alike & to their heirs & assigns for ever.

Lastly I nominate & appoint my loving wife Mary, & my brother Henry Hughes executors, of this my last will & test; hereby utterly revoking & disannulling all other and former wills, bequests, demises, & executors by me heretofore named, willed, bequeathed, devised & appointed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test. This 15 Day of November A. D. 1780.
