I Frederick Fisher of New, County & State of N^C Carolina (Planter) being very sick in body, but of perfect sound senses & memory thanks be to God for the same, calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do for the purpose of disposing of my estate & settling my affairs in full with each & every individual, make & ordain this to be my last will & test: I give my soul to God ~~that~~ I gave it, my body to the earth to be buried at christian manner, at the discretion of my after named executors

& as touching my worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

1. I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Ann the sum of one hundred pounds current money of N^C Carolina, I also bequeath unto her the negro woman Luce, I give unto her one choice of my horse creatures & four cows & six sheeps & six hogs her bed & furniture. I will that she shall have a pleasurable possession on the plantation I now live on, during the whole time she remains a widow, I will that my wife shall keep the fellow Carry & the smith tools during her widowhood to tend the plantation for her & to do the smiths work for my children, she may also keep two horses ploughs & gears during her widowhood, but in case my wife shall marry or die then in that case the fellow Carry & smith tools two horses, ploughs & gears shall be sold further I desire that the wagon shall be for the use of my wife during her widowhood.

2. I give & bequeath unto my eldest daughter Mary Eighty pounds current money of N^C Carolina. I bequeath unto her the Negro Girl Frank which she has in possession I also give & bequeath unto her the two hundred acres of land joining to Cresfons land & two cows.

3. I give & bequeath to my daughter Barbara the sum of Eighty pounds current money of N^C Carolina. I also give & bequeath unto her the Negro boy Toney which she has in possession I give unto her two cows, in case Henry Soufson my son in law will not accept of the above bequeaths then it shall be for his children in equal shares.

4. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Milly my Negro boy King & a negroe girl Rachel which she has in possession. I also give unto her two cows. I give & bequeath to her fifty pounds in money.

5. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Marcan the sum of one hundred & thirty pounds current money of N Carolina. I further give & bequeath unto her the plantation called Lenns place, one mare to be worth twenty pounds I give unto her, and two cows & I also give unto her a bed and furniture to the same.

6. I give unto my Daughter Christiana the sum of one hundred pounds current money of N Carolina. I also give & bequeath unto my said daughter Christiana the land from the cross road leading from Criders to Sallin-widens out, including Welkins place & Smiths place I give unto her a horse creature & saddle to be worth twenty five pounds. I also give unto her a bed & furniture for the same further I give unto her a negroe girl called Phillis and two cows interest of the £100. shall be paid to her from the day of my death.

7. I give & bequeath unto my son Charles the sum of one hundred pounds current money of N Carolina the interest of one hundred pounds shall be paid unto my said son from the date hereof. I also give & bequeath unto him the plantation on second creek. I bequeath unto him a horse & saddle, worth twenty five pounds & his colt which he has now I give unto him I also give unto him a new waggon I further give & bequeath unto him my negroe boy Abraham I give & bequeath unto him Joyles place I further bequeath

four steers to him, which shall be for his learning.

8. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Rosanna the plantation now live on including part of that land I bought of Cyder from the cross road in

I also give & bequeath unto her one hundred pounds current money of N Carolina, I also give unto her one horse creature & saddle with twenty five pounds & two cows. I give unto her a bed & furniture to the same, the interest on the money paid shall be paid unto my said daughter from the date of my death. I give & bequeath unto her my negroe boy Isaac.

9. I give & bequeath unto my daughters. I. sons Frederick Coble, Jacob Coble & Peter Coble the plantation of Joseph Hickman to be divided in equal parts amongst them.

10. I give & bequeath unto my eldest son Jacob three hundred Acres of land in the Waxhaws which I got from Charles Fisher I also give the hundred acres from Peter Little unto my son George I have given his full part.

I will that my after named executors, shall sell all my personal & moveable estate at such times, as they shall think proper executing such, as I have given & bequeathed but in case there should be a balance left after the legacies as aforesaid are paid, then it shall be equally divided amongst the children, in case either of my children should die before they are of age, or get his part, his share shall be equally divided amongst my children.

I do hereby constitute & appoint my eldest son Jacob & my wife Ann executors of this my last will & testament & I do hereby revoke & disallow all other wills legacies or bequests by me made, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be

my last will & test: In witness whereof I the said F. Fisher have hereunto set my hand & seal this 4th Day of December 22 1796.

And I will that none of my children shall be charged with any thing they have had in my life time

And I hereby make & ordain my sons: Jacob & Samuel executors of this my last will & test: In witness whereof I the sd John Lister have to this my last will & test: set my hand & seal, the day & year above written.
