

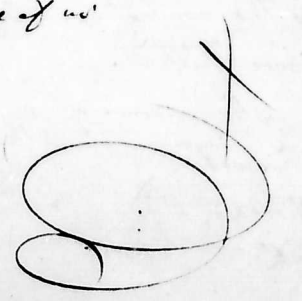
In the name of God Amen! State of N. Carolina Rowan County July the 22th 1807. I John Foreman being very weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God, do make this my last will & test: in manners & form as followed viz: that is to say

First of all it is my will that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid out of my personal property.

Item it is my will that all my personal property be sold & the money arising from the same to be equally divided between my children, that is to say to Hannah Fisk, Polly Fisk, Catharine Prothrope, Margaret Jones, Barbara Foreman & John Foreman.

Item then it is my will that my land estate be sold & the money arising from the sale be equally divided between my children as aforesaid.

I do hereby constitute & appoint my true & trusty friend Daniel Mattinger executor of this my last will & test: & do hereby rescind all former wills & test: made by me in any way, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test:

In the name of God Amen! I Frederick Long of the County of Rowan & State of N. Carolina being weak of body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given to almighty God, calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & test: that is to say: principally & first all I give give my soul into the almighty hands of God, who gave it & my body to the earth, to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors; nothing doubting, but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate, wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give & demise & dispose of the same in the following manner. & form.

Item. I give & bequeath to my well beloved son Joseph Long, the plantation whereon I now live, in Rowan County, containing Two hundred & Ninety two acres & also one tract of land in Cabanys County formerly Newburg containing One hundred & fifty acres of land, joining the lands of John Shelhoas & Martin Wister & also one black mare, & all my stock of horse & creatures & all my stock of cattle, sheeps & hogs, that I am or may be possessed of at my decease without exception & also all my ~~land~~ ploughs, gears, all my plantation tools of every kind without exception & also all my beds & house hold furniture of every kind that I am or may be possessed of at my decease & also one iron 16th harrow, all which articles I give & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Long, to him & his heirs forever & also I give to my son Joseph Long all notes

& bonds & books acct. that is or may be due to me at my
 decease & him to pay all my lawfull debts & funeral charges
 & I do make, constitute & appoint my s^r. son Joseph Long
 executor of this my last will & test. & I do hereby revoke
 & disannul all & every of my former wills, test. bequests
 & executors, by me in any wise before named, ratifying &
 confirming this & no other to be my last will & test. in wit-
 ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
 6th day of June A.D. 1794.

In the name God Amen! I Thomas Long of Rowan County
 & State of N^c Carolina, being of good sense & memory, but
 in a low state of health. I do hereby make & ordain this my
 first & last will & test. in a manner & form as followeth.
 Principally I recommend my soul in to the hand of almighty God
 hoping through the merits, death & passion of my blessed
 saviour Jesus Christ have full & free pardon, & forgiveness
 of all my sins, & to inherit everlasting life, & my body I
 give to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my
 executors, hereafter named, & as touching the disposition of
 all such temporal estate, wherewith it had pleased God to
 bestow upon me, I give & dispose thereof as followeth, first
 I will that all my debts & funeral charges be paid & discharged.
 Item. I give & bequeath to my wife Catharina Long the
 plantation whereon I now live on, to act & to use it as

her own during her widow hood & my son George Long to
 live with her until the younger son comes of age to assist
 & raise them, & if he uses to live with her then to take pos-
 session of the land & plantation that I had of Felix Howk
 but principally to keep my younger sons to yeather untill the
 age of twenty one I give him also one horse creature.
 Item. I give to my son John Long the twenty three acres of land
 & three quarters, that I bought of David Miris & also eight
 acres of land I had of John Long deced. also one horse creature
 Item. I give to my sons Thomas Long & David Long the land
 & plantation, lying east of the Bruskey fork to be equally
 divided between them according as they can agree, if they
 can not agree then each of them to choose two good men to
 divide it for them, & after the all come of age & take
 possession of the lands then each of them to give their mother
 ten bushels of wheat also ten bushels of corn, each of them
 yearly, also each of them to give their mother forty pounds
 of pork & forty pounds of beef yearly & as much good
 fodder as will winter two milk cows yearly.
 Item. I give to my daughter Mary Long two cows & one
 feather bed & furniture.
 Item. I give to my daughter Catharina Long two cows
 & one feather bed & furniture.
 Item. I give to my daughter Rose Long two cows & one
 feather bed & furniture.
 Item. I give to my daughter Christiana Long two cows
 & one feather bed & furniture.
 Item. I give to my daughter Sarah Long two cows & one feather
 bed & furniture.
