 of perfect mind & memory Thanks be given to God therefore  
 Calling to mind the mortality of the body & knowing it  
 is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & ordain  
 this my last will & testament that is to say principally  
 & first of all I give & recommend my soul unto the hands  
 of almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend  
 to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial after  
 the direction of my executors, nothing doubting but  
 at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again  
 by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly  
 estate where with it has pleased God to bless me in  
 this life I do give devise & dispose of in the following  
 manner & form.

Impres: I do give & bequeath to my dear & sons, William  
 Woods & Archibald Wood five shillings to each & no more  
 Then I do give & bequeath to my son Iron. Wood one bay  
 Mare which is at this time three years old & my Rifle  
 & no more — I do give to my son James Wood one  
 hundred acres of land lying strate across the south  
 & no more.

I do give & bequeath to my son John Wood one hundred  
 acres of land adjoining to his brother Henry & both  
 of their lands to run east & west & if Jones hundred  
 be sold had without taking in the buildings I would also

an off-set on the west end for the complement & no more  
 I do give & bequeath to my son Daniel Wood one hundred  
 acres of land adjoining land with my brother Iron Wood  
 & my son William Wood & no more I do give & bequeath  
 to my son Joshua Wood one hundred acres of land adjoining  
 my old tract & Jacob Cabbles land & no more — I do give  
 & bequeath to my eldest daughters Leah Cent & Ann  
 Barbara one cow & calf for each & no more I do & be-  
 queath to my four daughters to wit Sarah Wood &  
 Elizabeth Wood, Mary & Martha the sum of sixteen  
 pounds to be equally divided amongst them & it is my  
 desire & will that if any of the four should die before  
 the come of age that their part should be equally divided  
 among the rest — And it is my will & desire that if any  
 of the five boys that I have willed Land to should die before  
 the come of age the deceased part shall be equally divided  
 among the rest — I do give & bequeath to my son Garret  
 Wood all the rest of my land not here willed & bequeathed  
 & it is my will that this land which I have willed to my  
 son Garret shall be for my wife use as long as she remains  
 a widow in my name. — Likewise all the rest of my  
 moveable property to be at her use while she remains  
 a widow & if she marry or die the moveable property  
 to be sold & divided equally between five of my children  
 to wit, Sarah, Elizabeth Mary, & Martha & Garret  
 I do appoint & ordain George Road & Richard Wilson  
 Executors of this my last will & test: And I do hereby

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utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other will, legacies & bequeaths by my in any ways before named willed & bequeathed. Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day & year above written.

In the name of God Amen the 16 Day of February in the year of our Lord 1792. I Thomas Wilkeson in the County of Rowan & State of N Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks to God therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body & that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say principally & first of all I recommend my soul to God & the body to be buried in a christian & decent manner at the discretion of my executors. And as touching such words by estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in following manner & form  
Imprimis it is my will & do order that in the first place

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all my just debts & funeral charges be paid & satisfied. Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved son Thomas Wilkeson one Cow & his yearling that his own disposal. Item I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Rachel Wilkeson all my real & personal estate both stock of all kinds & household furniture to be left to her during her life time & after her decease then to be equally divided amongst all my well beloved children I likewise constitute make & ordain my well beloved wife Rachel Wilkeson my only & sole executer of this my last will & testament And I do hereby utterly disallow & disannul all & every other former wills, legacies & executors by me in any wise before this time named willed & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the Day & year above written. Signed, sealed & delivered in presence of us witnesses.
