

In the Name of God amen, I George
 Miller of Rowan County and Stat of
 North Carolina planter being in perfect
 Health and in sound and disposing Memory
 (Blessed be God) do this tenth day of sep-
 tember in the Year of our Lord one
 thousand seven Hundred eighty and five
 make and publish this my Last will
 and Testament in manner and form
 following: (that is to say) I give and
 bequeath to Glory Miller otherwise
 otherwise called Glory Lester one Negro
 Wench a Slave named Nanny and her
 Child named Lucy together with
 all and singular my horses Mares Cows
 Geese neat Cattle and hogs and all and
 singular my household Goods and furniture
 as also the whole of my moveable Estate
 which are mentioned in a deed of Gift
 made by me the said George Miller to
 her the said Glory Miller otherwise
 Glory Lester bearing date the seven, tenth
 day of december in the year of our Lord
 one thousand seven hundred & seven to them
 which I deed of Gift I do hereby Establish
 and absolutely Confirm

I also give and bequeath to my Son John Miller
 all that or parcel of Land lying situated and being
 on the southwest side of Abbeys Creek where the
 Lower or first line crosses the Creek running then
 along that line out of the 3^d Creek to the second
 corner thence Northward along the second line
 so far or as many chains as may be necessary to
 include two hundred Acres of Land including the
 Meadows of the southwest side or banks of Creek
 which is to be the boundary of the 3^d two hundred
 Acres and including the dwelling house Barns
 stables orchards and Improvements where the
 3^d George Miller now lives the 3^d lying in Rowan
 County and is the same Land mentioned in the
 deed of Gift made by me the 3^d George Miller to
 him the 3^d John Miller bearing date the sixth day
 of december in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and seventy three which 3^d deed of
 Gift I do hereby in my last will and Testament
 absolutely Establish and Confirm which I have
 and parcel of Land I give and bequeath to the
 3^d John Miller to his heirs and assigns forever
 I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob Miller
 his heirs & assigns forever all that Tract and parcel of
 Land situated lying & being in the County of Rowan
 aforesaid and on the Northeast side of Abbeys Creek
 Beginning at a black Oak near the Creek June
 the first corner of a Tract of three hundred & thirty

36) Acres heretofore granted to the said George Miller
by William Glen, Charles Stephenson and others
agents of Henry Custace M^cCallish Esq^r run-
ning thence to the said Abbot's Creek, thence
up the said Creek so far as to include one
hundred & twenty Acres so as not to interfere
with ten Acres of land part of the said three
hundred & thirty Acres tract by me the said George
Miller heretofore granted by deed of gift to my
two sons David & Fredrick Miller adjoining
to their mill on said Creek by this grant or con-
veyance more or less, being the same land men-
tioned in a deed of gift made by me the said
George a letter to him the said Jacob Miller
bearing date the seven day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven and
twenty three, which said Deed of gift I
the said George Miller in this my last will &
Testament do absolutely establish & confirm.

I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob Miller
his heirs & assigns forever one negro Girl
named Jenny being a Slave & the same neg^r
Girl that is mentioned in a Deed of Gift
made by me the said George a letter to him
the said Jacob Miller bearing date the seventh

day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand th
seven hundred & twenty three, which said deed of gift
I the said George a letter do in this my last will and
Testament & absolutely establish and confirm.

I also give & bequeath to my son the said Jacob Miller his
heirs & assigns forever all that Tract and parcel of land
situate lying & being in Rowan County aforesaid on
the East side of Abbot's Creek. Beginning at a black oak
in said Miller's line and corner to Doctor John
Dilling in a swamp & runs east forty six chains
to a black oak said Dilling's corner, thence north
fifteen & a half chains to a black gum in said
Miller's line thence west forty six chains to a stake
on said Miller's line, said Miller's corner of another
Tract thence south to the Beginning containing in the
whole eighty Acres. I also give & bequeath to my
sons Fredrick and David Miller their heirs and
assigns forever all that Tract & parcel of land lying
situate & being in Rowan County aforesaid on Abbot's
Creek containing two hundred Acres being the
Plantation which I the said George a letter par-
-chased of Henry Custace Esquire Attorney for Henry
Custace M^cCallish Esq^r as also ten Acres more of land
on the northeast side of said Creek adjoining to the
mill, which ten Acres is part of another Tract of
three hundred & thirty Acres heretofore granted to me

38) The said George Miller, by William John Charles
Stephenson & Agents, of the said Henry Custaw M'fal-
ter's L^{td} containing in the whole two hundred & ten
Acres together with the Mill & all appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way
appertaining. Also I give & bequeath to my sons
Frederick & David one negro boy named Jimmy
being a slave, to them their heirs & assigns forever
which is the said land & negro mentioned in a
deed of gift made by me the said George Miller
to them the said Frederick & David Miller bearing
date the first day of December in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy
three, which said Deed of Gift I do in this my
last will & Testament absolutely establish and
confirm. I also give & bequeath to my sons John
Miller, Jacob Miller, Frederick Miller and David
Miller their heirs & assigns forever the four follow-
ing Negroes being slaves, to wit Sarah Thom Betty
and Amy & their increase, but it is my will and
pleasure that Glory Miller otherwise called Glory
Lester have the use of them as long as she shall
live single & unmarried: but as soon as she
shall marry or at her death, that the said Negroes
& their increase be immediately divided between
my said sons & in case of the death of any
of my said sons, their heirs, share & share alike
as to make four equal divisions. And all

the residue of my personal estate which has not been heretofore
disposed of by deeds of gift or bequest principally will
away, which I shew in paper of, I will bequeath
to my four sons John Miller, Jacob Miller, Frederick
Miller & David Miller, their heirs & assigns forever to be
equally divided among them. And in case of the
death of any of them, their heirs, so that there shall
be only four equal divisions & so that the heir or heirs
of the deceased take only an equal share with any one that
shall survive. I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob
Miller his heirs & assigns forever all that part of an Oney
of land heretofore by me made on the late land of Oney & farm
which no deed or grant has been obtained, which shall be bequeath
above here after by me to be made & all above said land
give & bequeath to my ^{sons} Frederick and David Miller
their heirs & assigns forever. And I do ordain constitute
and appoint David Smith & John Billing my good
trusty & faithful friends the Executors of this my last
will & Testament, and I do hereby revoke disannul &
declare void all & every will by me heretofore made
and do pronounce declare & publish this my last will
& Testament, in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & affixed my seal the day & year first
above written. Signed, sealed, pronounced & declared
to be the last will & Testament of the said George
