In the Name of God am I S. George Miller of Rowan County and state of North Carolina planter being in perfect health and in sound and disposing memory (Blessed be God) do this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred eighty and four make and publish this my Last will and Testament in manner and form following: (that is to say) I give and bequeath to Glory Miller otherwise otherwise called Glory Lester one Negro Wench a Slave named Nancy and her Child named Lucy together with all and singular my horses Mares Waggon and singular Cattle and hogs and all and singular my household Goods and furniture as also the whole of my moveable Estate which are mentioned in a deed of Gift made by me the said George Miller to her the said Glory Miller otherwise called Glory Lester bearing date the seven last day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & four unto the which I deed of Gift I do hereby Establish and Absolutely Continue

I also give and bequeath to my Son John Miller²⁵ all tract or parcel of land lying situated and being on the southwest side of Abbott Creek where the Lower or first line crosses the Creek running ther along that line out of the sd Creek to the second corner thence Northward along the second line so far or as many chains as may be necessary to include two hundred Acres of Land including the Meanders of the southwest side or banks of Creek which is to be the boundary of the sd two hundred Acres and including the dwelling house Barns Stables orchards and Improvements where the sd George Miller now lives the sd lying in Rowan County and is the same land mentioned in the deed of Gift made by me the sd George Miller to him the sd John Miller bearing date the sixteenth of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy three which sd deed of Gift I do hereby in my last will and Testament absolutely Establish and Confirm which tract and parcel of Land I give and bequeath to the sd John Miller to his heirs and assigns forever I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob Miller & his heirs & assigns forever all that tract and parcel of land situated lying & being in the County of Rowan aforesaid and on the Northeast side of Abbott Creek Beginning at a black Oak near the Creek going the first corner of a tract of three hundred & three




runing thence to the said Abbott's Creek, thence
up the said Creek so far as to include one
hundred & twenty acres so as not to interfere
with ten acres of land part of the said one
hundred & thirty acre tract by me the said George
Miller heretofore granted by deed of gift to my
two sons David & Frederick Miller adjoining
to their Mill on said Creek be this grant or con-
veyance more or less, being the same land men-
tioned in a deed of gift made by me the said
George Miller to him the said Jacob Miller
bearing date the seven day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and twenty three, which said Deed of gift I
the said George Miller in this my last will &
testament do absolutely establish & confirm.

I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob Miller
his heirs & assigns forever one Negro Girl
named Jenny being a slave to the same Negro
girl that is mentioned in a deed of gift
made by me the said George Miller to him
the said Jacob Miller bearing date the seventh

day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred twenty three, which said deed of gift
I the said George Miller do in this my last will &
testament absolutely establish & confirm.
I also give & bequeath to my son the said Jacob Miller his
heirs & assigns forever all that tract and parcel of land
situate lying & being in Rowan County aforesaid on
the East side of Abbott's Creek. Beginning at a black oak
in said Miller's line and corner to Doctor John
Billing's in a swamp & running east forty six chains
to a black oak said Billing's corner, thence north
forty one & half chains to a black gum in said
Miller's line thence west forty six chains to a stake
on said Billing's line, said Miller's corner of another
tract thence south to the beginning containing in the
whole eighty acres. I also give & bequeath to my
sons Frederick and David Miller their heirs and
assigns forever all that tract & parcel of land lying
situate & being in Rowan County aforesaid on Abbott's
Creek containing two hundred acres being the
plantation which I the said George Miller pur-
chased of Henry Bustace Equire Attorney for Henry
Bustace M'Callum Esq^r as also ten acres more of land
on the northeast side of said creek adjoining to the
Mill, which ten acres is part of another tract of
one hundred & thirty acres heretofore granted to an

ler Esq: containing in the whole two hundred & ten
Acres together with the Mill & all & singular the
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any way
pertaining. Also I give & bequeath to my said
sons Frederick & David one negro boy named Jimmie
being a slave to them their heirs & assigns forever
which is the said land I negro mentioned in a
will of gift made by me the said George Miller
to them the said Frederick & David Miller bearing
date the first day of December in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & giving
there, which said Will of gift I do in this my
last will & Testament absolutely establish and
confirm. I also give & bequeath to my sons John
Miller Jacob Miller, Frederick Miller and David
Miller their heirs & assigns forever the four follow-
ing Negroes being slaves to wit Sarah Thom, Betsy
and Amy & their increase, but it is my sole and
pleasure that Glory Miller otherwise called Glory
Miller have the use of them as long as she shall
live single & unmarried, but as soon as she
shall marry or at her death that the said Negroes
other increase be immediately divided between
my said sons & in case of the death of any
of my said sons their heirs, share & share alike
as to make four equal divisions. And all

The residue of my personal estate which has not been disposed
of by Deeds of Gift or given specifically away,
which I have no property of, I will bequeath
to my four sons John Miller, Jacob Miller, David
Miller & David Miller, their heirs & assigns forever to be
equally divided among them. And in case of the
death of any of them, their heirs, so that there shall
be only four equal divisions & so that the wife or heirs
of the deceased take only an equal share with any one that
shall survive. I also give & bequeath to my son Jacob
Miller his heirs & assigns forever all that part of my Estate
of land heretofore by me made in the late land Office & from
which no deed or Grant has been obtained, which shall be below
a line hereafter by me to be made & all above said line I
give & bequeath to my sons Frederick and David Miller
their heirs & assigns forever. And I do ordain constitute
and appoint David Smith & John Bell my good
trusty & faithful friends the Executors of this my last
Will & Testament and I do hereby revoke absolutely
declare void all & every will by me heretofore made
and do pronounce declare & publish this my last Will
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & signed my seal the day & year first
above written. Signed, sealed pronounced & declared
to be the last Will & Testament of the said George
Miller in the presence of
