pounds sterling. I give & bequeath unto my
beloved James Son John ten pounds sterling.
I give and bequeath unto my beloved Martha
Parke daughter to Charles Parke fifty pounds
Currency of the State And in the next I give &
bequeath unto my beloved Sister Elisabeth Wife
to Robert McClelland of Shroville County Tippe-
rary in the Kingdom of Ireland all the remain-
ing part of my Estate. Which Legacies above men-
tioned except Martha Parke must be paid laid
out in Tobacco or flanneed as fast as the can
be collected & given into the hands of some of
the Merchants of Fayetteville for them to consign
them by way of their Friends in Ireland or Scot-
land to my Father John Hazlett in the Town of
Tipperary Munster Kingdom of Ireland for him
to distribute to them in what manner he sees
fit & for him to keep any part or parcel of said
Legacies in his own hands for his use and my
Mothers use if they stand in need of it. I desire
that all my real & personal Estate be sold at
public Vendue & that Twelve months be given

for payment of the money. I do desire that ^{part} of my Estate is found in my hands after my decease
that my honest debts be immediately paid and the remain-
der be immediately shipped off to my friends in Ireland
and as fast as the Executors collect in the debts that
be sent year by year also untill the whole is dis-
charged. And lastly I do hereby constitute &
appoint my beloved friends James Daniel Esq.
of Rowan County, Vtator aforesaid and William
McGriger Baptist preacher of Mountgomery Coun-
ty and State aforesaid whole & sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament in witness whereof I do
hereby set my hand & seal this 17th day of May

In the name of God Amen. I George Hartman
of the State of North Carolina Rowan County, Man-
ifesting weak in body but of sound & perfect mind
and memory, blessed be God, do this fourth day
of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
Seven hundred Eighty eight make and publish
this my last will & Testament in manner & form
following. I recommend my soul to God my Sav-
our Jesus Christ and I will that my body be

(108) intended in a christian like manner, firmly
believing that I shall rise hereafter at the Resur-
rection of the living, and that our labours for
his mercy's sake will let me be a partaker of
eternal happiness. I write that my just debts
be paid but as I have sold my live stock viz
horses mares real cattle sheep & hogs to my son
John six months past with that proviso that
I keep all during my natural life, therefore, after
my decease, it makes it no part of my estate,
and consequently my creditors can lay no claim
to it nor any part thereof. But it always was
my desire to pay my just debts I have bargained
with George Smith, John Herbet, Godfrey Aust,
Frederick Marshall, Peter Garside, Traugott Dagg,
Thomas Spieck, Charles Holder, Jacob Bonafant,
all of the State aforesaid Lenny County to mort-
gage all my real estate, that is to say my landed
property to them their heirs or assigns for one year
or during my life, & that to be their property if not
redeemed before, in order to prevent them from con-
secrating demands against me: but as I never
gave them a Mortgage deed, I desire my heirs
after named Executors to complete & accomplish
the same and to make them a right Mortgage
provided nevertheless that the above named

their heirs or assigns agree with my other creditors (109)
who have bonds or notes against me to pay them
share & share alike after the land is sold of the net
produce of said sale, that is to say, if the land should
fetch more than the above mentioned creditors have
against me, then & in such case these last mentioned
creditors that is not named to get their full due and the
rest to be divided among the owners of the mortgage
deed: but should it fetch less, then & in such case
to be divided share & share alike according as each
have a share therein. I give to my wife Mary all
my plate & household stuff and all moveable proper-
ty not otherwise herein mentioned or disposed of for
she got it by her industry. And I make and ordain
my said wife Mary my Executor and my friend John
Lib Shober my Executor of this my last willed testa-
ment to take care & see the same performed according
to my true intent & meaning. In witness whereof
the said George Hartman have to this my last will
and testament set my hand & seal the day and
