I bequeath to my dear Wife One Sow & Mare almost three years old Likewise three Cows and all my Sheep, also her Bed and bed Posts and Spinning wheel H.M. I order that my dear Wife shall have a sufficient maintenance of my Plantation and also food for as many Creatures as shall be necessary for her support. H.M. I bequeath to my son Nathaniel Brady One hundred and forty three Acres of Land wher he now lives running it across the East End of both my Old and new Survey. H.M. I bequeath to my son James Foster one Cow. H.M. I bequeath to my daughter Deborah One Sow & Mare six years old, her Sodde and Bridle likewise three Cows, also her Bed and Bed Posts. H.M. I bequeath to my son William one half of all my land, that remains after what is before bequeathed to be Divided at the Discretion of my Executors, Likewise one Bay Mare six or seven years Old, also one Bay Horse five Years Old and one Cow. H.M. I bequeath to my son

is above bequeathed also one Cow. Item I bequeath  
it to my three daughters Mary Sarah and Elizabeth  
what remains and is above after the above legacies  
are paid off of my Horses and House & Cattle. Item  
I order that all my Children that is unmarried shall  
have a right to live with my dear Wife on my Plantation  
and have equal rights to the Benefit of said  
Plantation as far as dues to their Maintenance and
