to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion  
of my Executors and as touching such worldly Estate whereto  
it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give  
divise and dispose the same in the following manner and  
form First I give and bequeath to Chrestiana my deare  
Beloved wife all my land household Goods debts and  
moveable Estate as long as she remains my widow  
and if she should marry again then my Estate to be  
Equally divided amongst my Children all but her  
yest I likewise constitute make and ordain D. P. & H.  
Leonard and Charles Berger the sole Executors of  
this my last will and Testament and do here by witness  
by D. P. & H. and witness all former wills Testaments  
Legacies and Executors Ratifying and Confirming this  
and no other to be my last will and Testament & inwrit-  
ings whereof I have hitherto set my hand and seal this  
Twenty fourt day of August in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and Eighty four signed sealed  
published pronounced and dictated by the said

In the name of God Amen It is known that George Parker  
of Bald Mountain District Rowan County being sick & weak but  
perfect mind & memory do make & ordain this my last will & testa-  
ment in the manner & form following Viz

I pray & desire I may be buried in a Christian like  
Decent manner & that my just debts may be paid by my Ex-  
ecutors whom I shall hereafter appoint I give & bequeath my  
Plat - lot & all my lands & tenements and plantation  
whereon I now live till my second son Joshua comes of age and  
then their plantation to be divided by two indifferent ho-  
nest men to be by them chosen & the amount to be equally  
divided between my three sons (to wit) my son John Dan-  
iel Parker & Jacob Miles Parker to be paid by my said  
son to the others at the time they shall arrive at the age  
of twenty one years & likewise that either of them <sup>my sons</sup> die before  
or Jacob Miles Parker should die before they <sup>their</sup> age  
that their part be equally divided between my daughters  
It is my will and desire that my beloved wife Agnes Parker  
whom I appoint my sole Executrix to this my last will & testament  
have her maintenance & live on my plantation during her  
Widowhood & it is likewise to have my gray Horse for her service  
I him give & bequeath to my second son John Parker my son  
Katherine his own use

I give to my daughter Elizabeth Park my Roan colt. Item give &  
bequeath to my daughter Mary my black mare. Item give & bequeath  
to my daughter Agnes Park my Roan mare. Item I give & bequeath to my  
son Joshua Park my colt belonging to the above s. Roan mare. Item it is my  
will & desire that all my stock of cattle to equally divided between  
all my children & that my youngest daughter Abigail Park  
have her equal share of my s. stock. And I do hereby now make &  
disannul all former wills or writings whereof I have hereunto  
my hand & seal this 13 day of September 1782

To all Christian People to whom these Presents may come  
greeting Whereas I Michael Wagner of the County of Orange  
Province of New Carolina calling to mind the uncertainty time  
do this thirteenth day of the eighth month in the year in the year of our  
Lord 1772 make & publish this as my last will & testament for me-  
nor & form as followeth. In the first place it is my will and desire  
that my body may be decently buried & decently that my just debts  
be paid. I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Ruth all  
my personal estate of every kind excepting my young mare of your  
old last spring of twenty two pounds in Money to answer the  
Inns live on to be laid up in bank and kept forth that pali-

use and service and to be produced when need shall be to see what land  
and meat a title for it is my will that and I give that the plantation  
I now live on shall be equally divided between my three sons  
it is my will that my son Joseph shall have the lower end of the  
tract joining the place Isaac Williams now lives on and it is my  
will that my son John shall have the middle of the aforesd tract  
parcel of land & it is my will that my son William shall have the  
upper end of the aforesd tract of land & it is my will that my  
son Meziah shall have the above mentioned <sup>young</sup> man of a year  
at least & it is my will that my three sons above mentioned  
shall each of them as they arrive to the age of twenty one years  
produce & spend which that is my will that the s. 15 pounds  
shall be equally divided between my two daughters namely  
Abigail & Ruth after they arrive to the age of 18 years  
it is my will that my Island wife shall have the use  
of a place I now live on until my son John shall arrive to  
the age of twenty one years & if she continues my widow  
it is my will that she shall have her maintenance of  
the aforesaid tract or parcel of land it is my will that my  
afforesd son shall bear an equal cost in maintaining her  
last I appoint my loving wife Ruth and my loving bro-  
in law John Pike of the aforesaid Province & con-  
county of Orange Executors of my last will for the intent
