Carolina an exalted to the sword as a soldier in defence of my country and not knowing when I shall be sherd to return again in case that if any with accident should happen I leave this behind me in place of a will & in the first place I leave my brother in law Leonard Boyder the whole manager of all my estate real & personal till my return & if I never return I give & bequeath to the sd. Leonard Boyder one strawberry near hors branded on the rear shoulder thus H & the rest of my estate I allow my brother Leonard Boyder to divide equally among all my brothers & sisters keeping to himself an equal part only my eldest brother Jacob if he dont sign a deed for 120 acres of land which I bought of my father & was administrator is to make use of sd. land he is to have no part ^{with} the rest but if he complys with my fathers bargain & signs the deed without trouble or feite he is to have an equal part with in sd. tracts where I have here un trest my hand & seal this 20 day of ^{July} 1790 in the year of our lord 1790

In the name of God Amen I Henry Shope of the state of N. Carolina and county of Rowan being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory do hereby acknowledge this to be my last will & testament. Firstly I do will & bequeath unto my beloved wife christiana all my track and parcel of land & two cows & likewise my hagen to have to hold so long as she remains my widow & if she marrieth I do hereby allow my Executors to put out my plantation to the best advantage until my three sons is of age and then to be equally divided amongst them. Secondly I do will and bequeath unto my wife Chrisana one bed & bedding. Thirdly I do will & bequeath that all the remainder of my moveable property to be wanded sold and that my wife Chrisana to have & to hold one third part of my estate & the remainder to be equally divided among my children. Fourthly I do hereby appoint Col. John Lopp & Phillip Leonard Executors of this my last will & testament. Signed & delivered in the presence of us this 22^d day of october 1790
