In the name of God Amen! I Menay Leonard of Rowan County & State of N^c Carolina being of sound & perfect mind & memory blessed be God, do this twelfth Day of October in the year of our Lord 1803 make & publish this my last will & Test: in manner following that is to say *first*:

I give & bequeath unto Elizabeth my dearly beloved wife the use of my farm & dwelling house & all necessary buildings, with the use of fire wood & any necessary timber for the repair of said farm & use of two plough & two pair of geese & one of my mares her choice & two milch cows her choice & two beds & furniture & two sheeps during her widowhood & no longer.

And likewise that my said wife shall have for the support
of my family the first year what grain I have in hand &
what grain I have growing in the field & one dry cow & my

largest steer for beef & two sides of solt leather, & two sides of upper leather to make my family shoes, & four barrow & one cow & five shoats her choice for the family support. And the rest of my moveable estate shall be sold at public sale & the money equally divided, so that my wife & children shall all have equal shares after my just debts are paid. And in case my wife should marry again the property I have left to her use of or in case of her death shall be immediately sold at public sale & the money arising from the sale shall be equally divided so that my wife shall have no more than an equal child's part with my children of the moveable estate, & in case of her death her part shall go to my children equally, & in case my wife should either die or marry before my youngest son comes to the age of twenty one years my lands shall be rented & the money shall be equally divided among my children. I give & bequeath unto my two sons namely Charles & Jacob when my youngest son is arrived to the age above mentioned to have my land equally divided between them, upon their paying my three daughters ninety dollars, to wit, thirty dollars each year by each of my sons, so that the payment shall be made in three years from the time my youngest son is of the age above mentioned. And I likewise will that in case my wife should die or marry that my daughters should be bound out at the discretion of my executors, & likewise I will that my sons be bound out to some good trade at the discretion of my executors to be learned the art & mystery of their trade & likewise to read & write sufficient

for common business. And I hereby make & ordain my worthy friends Jacob Houlton & John Linn executors of this my last will & test: in witness whereof I the said Henry Leonard have hereunto this my last will & test: set my hand & seal the day & year above written.

Signed, sealed, published, & declared by the said Henry Leonard the testator as his last will & test: in the presence of us who were present at the time of signing & sealing thereof. *Thos. To. Lyeall.*

Carolina farmer, being very sick but of perfect sound senses & memory thanks be to God for the same knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do for the purpose of settling all my affairs with every person; & to give & dispose of my worldly estate to my well beloved wife & children to my own mind; do make & ordain this to be my last will & test: in the following manner & form.

First I do direct & will that all my just debts shall be paid & also my funeral charges out of my estates.
Secondly I do direct that my well beloved wife Margaret shall have a possible & quiet possession of my house & plantation during her natural life, and I do further give to my said wife Margaret, one bed & furniture & her spinning wheel, two cows & three sheeps & weaving loom & two pigs & I do further give her my old mare & a two year old mare colt & afterwards to go a equal share, with my three children, George, Catharine &
