I ordain that my beloved wife Hannah Owings shall have fifty acres of land to conclude my house & orchard out of Henry's part during her natural life & all my stock & household furniture. And at her decease the land to revert back to Henry. I ordain that my grand daughter Helena Roberts shall have the sum of twenty pounds hard money paid to her by my four sons, Bazabel, Norman, John & Henry Owings. I then ordain that my daughter Sarah Owings, shall keep the two creatures that she has now in possession. I ordain that my son Henry Owings have one bed & furniture, & one cow & one heifer & no more of my personal estate. And at the decease of my beloved wife. I ordain that Sarah Owings & her living & Helena Roberts shall have an equal divide, together with all the personal estate remains. And lastly of all I hereby

make & ordain my two sons Norman & Henry Owings, executors of this my last will & test in witness whereof I the said Elijah Owings sen: have to this my last will & test: set my hand & seal the day & year above written

I give & bequeath to John Long & Henry Day my first & sole executors of this my last will & test:

I do give & bequeath to my brother Benjamin one half of this plantation, where I now live on, to be run off & divided equal between Benjamin Owen & Edward Owen & Stephen Owen which, when the come of age I desire that my part of the land may be equally divided between Edward Owen & Stephen Owen & the land up at Quicks place, Desire that William Owen may have the privilege of building & cultivating & improving the same free from rent for the space of fifteen years, & then give up possible possession & as for my personal & moveable property. Desire that my executors may make & vendue the same at

it is my desire that after all my debts is paid, that there may be a equal division made of the balance, among my three sisters, ^{& their spouses} named Judy Owen, Mary Owen & Patty Sudles, my three sisters & Lucy Owen a daughter of Judge Owen & after my decease I desire that an inventory may be taken. There unto do set my hand in presence of the witnesses this 18th day of September AD 1794.

Blessed be God I give my body to the earth, from which it was taken in full appearance of its resurrection from thence at the last day. As for my burial, I desire it to be decent without pomp or state at the discretion of my dear wife & my executors hereafter named which they will manage it with all requested prudence.
