of five and Twenty pounds each North Carolina Cur-
rency to be paid within the term of four years after
my decease, Elizabeth is to have her saddle and Bridle
furniture and after my just debts are paid the re-
mainder is to be equally divided between my four
sons, and I do hereby nominate, constitute and
appoint my dear and loving Wife, and my son
Samuel and my trusty friend David Caldwell
Executors of this my last Will and Testament, hereby
abolishing and Divanulling all former Wills &
Testaments by me heretofore made, and all legacies
Bequests and Executors by me in any ways before
this time Willed and bequeathed, ratifying and con-
firming this and no other to be my last Will
and Testament in witness whereof I have

ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to
say principally and first of all, I give and command
my soul into the hands of God who gave it and my
body to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
I shall receive the same against the general judgment
through the mighty power of God, and as touching those
Worldly Goods wherewithal it hath pleased God to bless
me in this life I give devise & Dispose of them in
manner and form following (viz)

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna the sum
of five Hhds. Spine to be paid unto her by my Executor
after my Decease, also I give and bequeath unto my
Grand Daughter Mary Chambers the sum of forty pounds
Spine provided she shall live unto the age of Twenty One
Years at which time the said Legacy of forty pounds shall
become due and shall be paid unto her by my Executor
or by his Heirs or Executors, and provided she the said
Mary Chambers shall die in her Minority, that is to say
before she shall arrive at the age of Twenty One Years then
the said legacy of Forty pounds shall devide unto my
Son Robert - Also Spine and bequeath unto my Son Robt
all and singular my Goods, Chattels Rights & Credits what-
soever and my plantation of land situate lying and
being in the County of Rowan on the waters of Old water
Creek which said plantation is now in the possession
of my son in law, Thomas Lewis and I do hereby
constitute and appoint my Son Robert Executor of
this my last Will and Testament, by whom all my
just Debts shall be paid, and also the above legacies
Distributed according to the intent and true mean-
ing of these presents, and I do hereby make void
all other Wills that I have made before this date by
pronouncing and declaring this, and no other to be
my last Will and Testament, So witness
