Will and Testament, And Do hereby disannul
and make void all other Wills, Malletions and Ploughing
Horse and no other to be my last Will and Testament
In witness whereof I have caused to set my hand and
affixed my seal this twenty third day of Feb: anno domini

day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand seven
hundred and eighty six, I Wright Tomlin of the County of
Rowan, and State of North Carolina Farmer, being infirm
and weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory, thanks
be given unto God for the same, and calling to mind
the mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appain-
ing for all men once to die, do make and ordain this
my last Will and Testament, that is to say, principal
ly and first of all, I give and command my soul

the wearing Apparel of my well beloved Wife Mary who
is diseased Ague and bequeath unto my Daughter
Mary (as before mentioned) to be sold and equally di-
vided amongst them in the best manner my
Executors shall see most proper for them to receive it
I do also constitute and appoint my well beloved
friend and Father Samuel Ellis Esq: with my
beloved friend and Brother Bucket Tomblin to be
the sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament
And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannule
all and every other former Testaments Wills & Legacies
Requests and Executors by me in any way before this
time named willed, and bequeathed ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my last Will and
Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal the day and year above written, signed
sealed published and pronounced and declared by the
said Hugh Tomblin as his last Will and
