Will and Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give &
recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it &
my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like
Manner at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing dreading but at
the general Resurrection I shall recover the same again by the Mighty
Power of God except as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has
pleased God to bless me in this life I give & devise & dispose of the same
in the following Manner & Form First my Will is that all my
just Debts & General Charges be first paid out of the first things
arising from the sale of such Part of my Estate as may be sold or
Money due to me is collected. Secondly I give and bequeath unto
my beloved Daughter Sarah Page one Cow & Calf one Heifer & one Mare
called Jane to her the said Sarah Page her Heirs & Assigns. Thirdly
I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Mary Page one Cow called
Dort one young Heifer called Wilky, four young Horses & two young
Hogs & two young Calves one small Mare & Calf & one young black
Horse & the young Calf that belongs to the Cow called Jane which
is bequeathed unto Sarah & twelve Hairs of Horses also my Room
and Goods & all my Household Furniture of what Kind soever with
all the Rest &余 of my Estate both real & personal wheresoever
the same may be found unto her the said Mary Page her Heirs
& Assigns forever. And lastly I do hereby nominate, constitute
and appoint my trusty & beloved Friends John Troxell and Thomas
Troxel my Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby de-
nouncing all other Wills or Wills by me hitherto made &

Executor Richard Simpson & Peter King who the same is at
my Land & get my Deed for my son of the
