

In the name of God Amen.

I Jacob Hughey of the County of Rowan and State of North Carolina being at this time in sound mind and perfectly in my senses, do make this my last Will and Testament. I bequeath my soul to God, the father from whom I received it, and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent and christian like manner: and as to my worldly estate my desire is that it should be disposed of in the following manner vizt.

To my dearly beloved wife Margaret I bequeath the use of our plantation on which we live, during her widowhood, or until my son Henry Hughey arrives of full age - should she marry before that time then the plantation to be applied by the Executors to the benefit of the Children. I also bequeath to her the Negro fellow Jack, on the same conditions as the plantation, only that in case of marriage the negro to be sold & to be applied with other property herein after mentioned to the use of the Children. I also bequeath to my said wife and to her assigns to be disposed of as she thinks proper her choice two of my horses, her choice of a feather bed & bedding, two pots, two pewter dishes & six plates.

2) I bequeath to my son Henry Hugg my plan-
tation on which I live and also the Negro boy
Andy. I desire & empower my Executors to sell
a tract of Land adjoining the plantation
last mentioned abt one hundred & forty acres
two negro wenchs and all my other prop-
erty not already disposed of; and after paying
all my just debts, the remainder to be equally
divided among all the children (the negro
fellow Jack, in case of the marriage of my
wife to be included in the above sale)
And whereas there is a probability that my
wife may now be pregnant; if so, and that a
boy should be born, and arrive of age, he is
to divide the plantation with his brother
Henry - should it be a girl, to have an equal
division of the above mentioned property.
And whereas my father left a Wagon to my
brother Henry & me, my will is that the said
Wagon continue unsold for the use of
both families as at first intended. I do con-
stitute and appoint my brothers Henry &
Robert to be my Executors to this my last will
and Testament signed with my hand and
dated the sixth day of January in the Year
of our Lord 1792.

or writing, and this is to be taken only for my last
will and Testament and no other. And first be-
ing penitent and sorry from the bottom of my
heart for my sins past, most humbly desire forgive-
ness for the same, I commit my soul unto almighty
God my Saviour and Redeemer in whom and
by the Ministry of Jesus Christ, I trust and believe
assuredly to be saved and to have full remission
and forgiveness of all my sins, and that my
soul with my body at a general day of Resur-
rection shall rise again with joy and through
the merits of Christ's death and passion, possess
and inherit the Kingdom of Heaven, prepared
for his elect and Chosen, and my body to be
