 tian manner at the discretion of my Executors
 nothing doubting but I shall receive the same at
 the general Resurrection by the mighty power of
 God — and as touching such worldly Estate where-
 with it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life
 I give, demise and dispose of in the following manner
 and form and in the first place I allow all my law-
 full debts to be ~~paid~~ discharged. ~~and~~ ~~and~~ ~~and~~ I give
 and bequeath to my beloved son John a Certain Tract
 of Land lying on the Catawba River betwixt where I
 now reside and Richard Lewis's Plantation beginning

at Richard Lewis's Corner on the River bank and run-
 ning along said line about 100 poles either more or
 less as may be most convenient in the Division of
 the Tract I now live in and then to Corner on Richard
 Lewis's line and then to the first Branch and from
 thence to the River and likewise to my son John there
 the following Horses namely Doctor Dick and Jack
 and two fillies — I give and bequeath to
 my son James a Tract of land lying North from John's
 land upon a branch called the long Branch not limited
 but to be measured as may seem most convenient to
 the advantage of the whole tract together with the following
 Creatures by whom called Guy, his own mare and
 Colt and a three year old filly. I give and bequeath
 to my son Henry a Tract of land wherein the small stream
 Improvement is made lying on both sides of the Creek
~~and~~ I give to my son Jacob the Improvement wherein I
 now live with a part of the land lying adjacent thereto
~~and~~ I give to my son W^m One hundred pounds to be
 laid out of my personal Estate. ~~and~~ I give to my
 Daughter Elizabeth One hundred pounds to be laid
 out of my personal Estate. I bequeath to my Daughter
 Anne One hundred pounds to be laid out of my
 Estate and put to her hand till she is capable of
 keeping it

I give and bequeath to my Beloved Wife Margaret the
Negro wench named Rose as her property during her
Widowhood, and if she should Marry then the Wench to be
sold and the value thereof to be divided into four equal
Shares herself a part, & my apd Elizabeth a part and
Anne a part thereof, or if it should please God to call
her hence her said Wench to be sold and her value
Equally Divide among my three last mentioned
Children and my above named Wife likewise allow
her the benefit of a widowhood on the Improvement I
now have during her Widowhood, and the care and
Fuction of my two youngest Children Jacob & Ann
I leave to their Mother's discretion till they come to the
Years of Majority and for the support of her and them
together I have all my Household furniture in general
including all Implements of Husbandry such as may
be necessary in upholding a farm as long as in her
Widowhood as above and to my Wife I leave the Gray
Mare, and two Cows and all the Cow house in
general together with all the sheep including her
Pew saddle, and I do Constitute Appoint and ordain
my Son John and James Thomas to be the sole
Executors of this my last will and Testament and
none other, & I do hereby Disabllor Testate and Disannul

all and every other former Testaments Wills
Legacies Bequests and Test^{ts} by me before in any
Wise mentioned named Wills and Bequests etc. Noty
ping this and no other to be my last will and Tes-
tament. At W. T. M. S. whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and Seal this fourteenth day of April in the year
of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and Twenty
