it hoping through the death mists and Enterscission of my Lord
and saviour Jesus Christ to have a full and free pardon and
forgiveness of all my sins and to inherit everlasting life and
my Body I commit to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian
burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter named nothing
doubting but to receive the same again at the General Resurrection
by the mighty power of God And as touching such worldly Estate
wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life & give
Demise & bequeath and dispose of in the following manner and
form (viz) It is my will and pleasure that all those just debts
and Duties as I owe to any manner of person or persons whomsoever
either in Law or Equity be first paid in some convenient
time after my death by my Executors hereafter named

Item I give demise and bequeath unto my Beloved son William
Brandon that tract of land whereon he now lives Beginning at
the mouth of the spring Branch on the North side of fourth
Creek and running up said branch to the head thereof thence
a west course to the boundary line of said Tract thence the course
is of the original Head to the mill I am thence down the course of
the dam and Creek to the Beginning including the gristmill with
one third part of the saw mill only and my Negro wench Deborah
and her Child called Yank and to his Heirs and assigns forever
&c.

Item I give demise and bequeath unto my Loving son Benjamin
Brandon Two Hundred Acres of my Land on the north side
of fourth Creek including the improvements where he now lives
Beginning at the Original Beginning comes on the North side

50) of fourth Creek and so round according to the course is
for compliment and my Negro fellow called Paul
and one third part of the saw mill to his heirs &
assigns for ever.

Item I give devise and Bequeath unto my Loring
son John Brandon all the remainder of my Land on
the North side of fourth Creek lying between William
& Benjamin parts aforesaid and my Negro fellow
Harry and to his heirs and assigns forever and one third part
of the saw mill.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jane
Wilson my Negro wench Hannah and all and singular
her sisters apparel and bed and bed cloather and the
sheet called Marys and to her assigns and heirs forever.

Item I give and bequeath and demise unto my Loring
son Abel Brandon one half of the plantation &
labor on the south side of fourth Creek both in Quantity
& Quality and my Negro wench called Kate and my
Oar Colt and to his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item I give Bequeath and demise unto my Loring
son Armstrong Brandon the remainder of my planta-
tion where on I now live on the south side of fourth Creek
and my Negro wench Dinah the half of my sheet and
my Oar fley and to his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved
Wife Rebecca her dower of and in all my Land
on the south side of fourth Creek devised as aforesaid
to my two Sons Abel and Armstrong together
with all and singular my house hold furniture
and use of my mentioned house my negro man
Peter with oars the one half of the sheet and my
Court and to his heirs and assigns for ever.
