In the name of God Almighty I Hanover Carson
of the County of Rowan and Province of North Carolina
being sick in body but of good and sound Memory
thankes be to Almighty God do make ordain and
appoint this my last Will and Testament and first
I commit my soul to the God my Saviour and
Redeemer my body to be buried in such a place when
it shall please my Executors hereafter named to ap-
point the expence to be by them paid out of my
Worldly Substance and now for the settling of
my temporal Estate, and such Goods Chattels
and debts as it has pleased God to bestow upon me
I do ordigne and dispose of the same in manner
and form following. First I will that all my law-
full debts and dues that I owe to any person

or persons whatsoever shall be well and truly
contented and paid or ordained to be paid within
convenient time after my decease by my Executors
hereafter named, and first I allow my family to
remain together till such time as they think fit to
part, and to have the benefit of what they can make
amongst them of of the Plantation wheror knowlde
I likewise allow my Waggon, Hars and all my
Plantation tools to remain on the Plantation for the
benefit of my family if they see cause to live on
the land, and that my wife have the management
of my Children till such times as they come to years
of ~~matrity~~ discretion and likewise allow my
Children to be schooled as far as is common, and
to be paid out of my Estate, Item I give and bequeath
unto my wife Hanover Carson the two Negro men
named Primus and Jack and likewise the wench
named Sally, together with the sucking Child named
Abner and her choice of the two best Beds and Beding
that I am now in posseesion of and likewise share
the Propr and furniture, and a Horse and
Saddle and her thirds of what is made on the
Plantation

160th while she lives, Item I give unto my son John one
Negro boy named Samson and likewise the one
half of a lot of land in Salisbury, distinguished by
the mark of number five, Item I give unto my son
Thomas one quarter lot of land in Salisbury known
by the name of Number one in the North square
Item I give unto my son James 328 Acres of land
lying on both sides of Grants creek and joining
to Techauks plantation, and I give unto my son
Henry and my son William the plantation where
we now live to be equally divided amongst them
Item I give unto my son Thig 560 acres of land
lying in the forks of Bear creek on the North side of the
South River which land I allow to be sold and the
money to be laid out on him in learning or if any
of my other sons like to keep the land I allow them to
have it and to pay 250 pounds for it and the money
to be laid out on him in learning and such other
things as my Executors shall think fit, Item I
give unto my Daughter Prudence one young Negro
which I named poll, Item I give unto my Daughter
Honour a negro boy named Primus, Item I
give unto my Daughter Mary a young Negro

16th which I named Rachel, Item I allow the rest
that is now due or all the land left or made
over to my Son to be paid out of the remainder of
my Estate and the rest is to be equally divided am-
ongst my children, I likewise give my executors
leave either to sell the rest of my effects or to choose
three men and have them prised, and I likewise give
my Executors leave to sell any of the land which I
give to any of my Sons, if they see it will answer better
or as the money be laid out in other land or some
other thing more to their advantage, so that the lega-
taries shall not be confined to live on any land
that I now hold, if they see a better prospect anywhere
else, and I do hereby nominate and appoint my
Wife Honour Carson and my son John Carson and
my son Thomas Carson the sole Executors of this my
last Will and Testament, hereby revoking and
disannulling all former will or Wills heretofore
by me made, Ratifying and confirming this to be
my last Will and Testament in witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this tenth
day of Oct. in the year of our Lord 1773

the worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this life world I do dispose of in the following man
ner and form viz — principally and first of all
I allow my lawfull and just Debts and funeral
charges to be paid. Then I give and bequeath to my
Bansay my well beloved wife one black Mare named
Polly & Saddle and Bridle Spinning wheel Bed and
Bed clothes and if she chuse to remain with my son
Andrew to have a good maintenance off my Estate
or part thereof bequeathed to him the said Andrew
& a decent Burial if she remains with him until
the end of her time in this world. Then I give and
bequeath to my Son William Esq; of Priddy
James two fowounds and a thick cloth white hat
Then I give and bequeath my Son William two
Pounds
