and Testament and none other and first be-  
ing penitent and sorry for my vicious past  
committed against a kind and mercifull God  
most humbly desiring forgiveness of the same  
I give and commit my soul unto Almighty

the Merits of Jesus Christ I trust and believe af-  
furedly to be saved and that my soul with my bo-  
dy at a general day of Resurrection shall arise  
again with joy and through the Merits of Christ's

of Heaven prepared for his elect and chosen

fit and now for the settling my temporal

I give and Bequeath my Silver Watch  
Nine Buckles with all my Cloathing now at  
Brother Samuel except my Clock but aside  
and Brads and unto Martha Houston Oldest  
Daughter of Brother Samuel I give and  
Bequeath the towel cheare which I bought  
of William Sharpe now in the care of Petter  
Peter upon Clock and unto my Father  
Robert Houston I give and Bequeath my  
Clock and that Bond upon brother James  
which was signed to me I wife and Bequeath  
unto brother Robert Houston all the

in his possession with my plow and tooling  
thereunto belonging and what Cloathing I  
left at Robert Edmonstons with what  
Cora Francis last year and what is coming  
of Robert Edmonstone which is to be paid in
