 I Richard King of Essex county and state of North Caro-
 lina being very weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory,
 thanks be given unto god; Therefore calling to mind the
 mortality of my body, & knowing that it is appointed
 for all men once to die, To make & Ordain this to be my
 last Will & Testament; That is to say principally & first
 of all, I give & recommend my soul into the hands of al-
 mighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the
 earth, to be buried in decent Christian burial, at the
 discretion of my executors; Nothing doubting but at
 the general Resurrection, I shall receive the same
 again, by the mighty power of God; & as touching
 such worldly estate as it hath pleased god to bestow

 in the following manner & form ———
 First I give & bequeath to Margaret my dearly be-
 loved Wife, my negro wench named Monah, Sagon,

 Nowhols goods & moveable Effects, Likewise the
 privilege of the Land I have upon to clear & cut
 Wood at pleasure during Life; I order my moveable
 Effects as hereunto to be sold at publick vendue per
 bidding horse excepted, Likewise a cow and calf which
 I bequeath to my grand daughter Margaret Lane, &
 the money of said Effects to be put to interest for the use
