I James Woods of Rowan County in the State of N^o Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thank be given unto God & calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say principally & first I recommend my soul to God & my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my executors. & as touching such worldly estate whereby it has pleased God to bless me in this life I

give devise & dispose of in following manner & form viz. First I give unto Samuel Woods his my Proprietary share & then the remaining part of my estate real & personal I desire shall be sold to all my debts paid & the remaining part to be equally divided between my brother Andrew & Samuel & Alexander Woods & my sisters Margaret which I desire that each & every one of them shall have an equal division of the whole estate & further that the Samuel Woods his share after getting the same above mentioned he is to have an equal share with the rest of the heirs also I do hereby make constitute & ordain Andrew Woods & Samuel Woods & John Woods executors of this my last will & testament & I do hereby make void all others wills made by me heretofore ratifying & confirming this my last will & testament.
