And the said Mary Byrn is to have one black walnut chest. And I do give my son Thomey Byrn one hundred & forty acres of Land, where he now lives and further give & bequeath to my son Charles Larin Byrn one hundred acres of land where he now lives & further I give & bequeath unto my son John Byrn

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one hundred acres of land where he now lives & I give & bequeath unto my son William Byrn one hundred acres of land and to the last of all I give & bequeath unto my son Temple Cole Byrn one hundred acres of land out of the said tract and further I appoint my son Thomas Byrn & Thomas Fox to be my executors & I do hereby revoke, disannul & make void any will or testament, by me made or caused to be made this to be my last will & test: and no other therefore made I have therunto set my hand & seal this 5 day of July 1797.
