In the name of God Amen! I James Macay of the County  
of Rowan & State of N<sup>o</sup> Carolina being weak in body yet  
of sound mind & memory thanks be to God for it & calling  
to mind that it is appointed for all men to die & considering  
the mortality of my body, do make constitute & ordain this to  
be my last will & testament that is to say principally & first  
of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of that God  
who gave it & for my body I recommend it to be buried in a Christian  
like manner at the discretion of my executors hereafter to  
be named, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I  
shall receive it again by the power of almighty God & as  
touching such worldly property as it had pleased God to  
bless me with in this life I give will & dispose of it in the  
following manner that is to say.

I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Esther Macay my  
bed & furniture together with her right of dower in my lands  
as reserved in a Deed of conveyance which I made to my son  
Wilson Macay as will appear of record.

2. I give & bequeath to my son Horace Macay five shillings  
sterling if legally demanded & my Clock, he paying to my son  
James forty dollars twelve months after my decease

3. I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth wife of Radford  
Ellis one negro wench named Jane one feather bed & furniture  
two cows & one womens saddle now in the possession of her  
husband Radford Ellis.

4. I give & bequeath to my son John one Negro slave named  
Peter & a mare & saddle which he has sold.

5. I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah wife of Robert  
McKee one Negro named Sylvia one feather bed & furniture  
one cow & calf & five pounds of money

6. I give & bequeath to my daughter Anne wife of Henry Lotton  
one Negro girl named Amy & one feather bed & furniture &  
one sorrel horse now in the possession of her husband & five  
pounds in money.

7. I give & bequeath to my son Wilson two Negroes one  
named Henry & the other Lucy & one feather bed & furniture  
all which are in his possession be performing the concert  
for which I have his obligations respecting his brother Dan  
& sister Hannah & James his brother.

8. I give & bequeath to son James one negro girl named  
Biddy & one bed & furniture after my decease & all the  
residue of my moveable property after my just debts &  
legacies before mentioned are paid, except one negro man  
named Tom which I give & bequeath to my son Wilson.

9. I give & bequeath to my son Daniel one negro girl  
named Pitty which said girl is to remain in the possession  
of my daughter Anne from the time of my decease till my  
son Daniel is of age.

90. Lastly I ordain constitute & appoint my son James Macay  
the sole executor of this my last will & test, hereby directing  
him, to make sale of the whole of my moveable property which  
is not bequeathed above, to enable him to discharge my just  
debts & likewise to plead the Statute of limitation against  
all accounts which may be brought against my estate,  
where the Statute will be. I do hereby appoint my son George  
guardian for son Daniel & daughter Hannah.

In the name of God Amen! I Dennis Nathan of Rowan  
County & State of N<sup>o</sup> Carolina being aged, sick in body but  
of sound mind & disposing memory & calling to mind the  
uncertainty of life & the many embarrassing evils that often  
attend the families. Do make & declare this my last will & test.  
Item first & above all it is my will & testament earnestly  
desire that all my just debts be paid & my funeral ex-  
penses discharged.

Item. 2. I will & bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy  
the one third part of all my real estate, including the  
dwelling house, we now live in, and as much of the other  
improvements as may be deemed necessary for her support  
and due regard being had to her circumstances & the family  
that may live with her during her natural life.  
I also will & bequeath unto my wife aforesaid a horse.

91. creature, which I wish to be about the third in value of all  
I dispossess of, two cows with their last calfs, her choice of  
two sheep, two breeding sows, her bed & furniture, the largest of  
our poto & a dutch oven, two pewter dishes a set knives & forks  
six spoons, a walnut Table, three chairs a flax wheel & reel,  
all our earthen ware, including tea ware, six tin cups & coffee pot  
& a third part of what humours death & yarn may happen  
to be on hand at the time of my decease. These things I will &  
bequeath to her & her heirs forever.

Item 3. I give & bequeath unto my daughter Eleanor & her  
heirs for ever two milk cows to be assigned to her by my  
executors hereinafter named together with her bed & furniture  
& other things heretofore called hers.

Item 4. I give & devise to my three sons Peter James & Samuel  
McNathan & their heirs for ever all the tract or parcel of  
land I now live on containing by estimation 450 acres to  
be divided between them as near as may be both in quantity  
& quality so that Peter shall have his part on the east side  
James the middle part including the dwelling house & other  
buildings & Samuel his part on the west side of the tract, I  
also give & bequeath unto my son Peter one cow, two pairs of  
horse gears a plough & a mattock provided that he pay unto  
my daughter Agnes twenty dollars in three yearly payment  
after she arrives to the age of twenty one years.

I also give & bequeath unto my s<sup>r</sup> son James my waggon  
two pair of horse gears one horse the first in Value, I  
dispossess of two cows a plough, mattock &c provided  
he pay unto my daughter Jane twenty d<sup>r</sup> m<sup>r</sup> & the
