ber 1685 I Robert McQuiston of the Province of North Caro-
lina and County of Rowan being infirm in Body but of
sound Memory & Judgment do make & publish this my last
Will & Testament whether by word or writing if such be made
by me First I bequeath my Soul to God waiting through Faith
in Christ my Saviour for that Merit promised to them
that live in him and my Body to be entred as my Executors shall
think fit. First of all to pay my just Debts & to divide my
Estate as followith to wit. First of all I give to my dear-
ly beloved Wife Ann McQuiston & my Son Walter McQuiston
all my Estate Debts and Mortgagels equally to be divided between
them except what I shall hereafter bequeath to the Rest of
my Children with my Plantation and all the Appurtenances ther-
unto belonging during her Life time or Widowhood then to my
Son Walter McQuiston if maried againe I allow her but twenty
Pounds and her Riding & Kind of Cloas with a French Jewell
and her part of the Monies to her to dispose as she shall think fit
and my loving release to divide them as she thinks fit. Secondly
I give my Son James McQuiston twenty Pounds and

in Windsor to two dear Robert M. Levenson. Finally I give to John
Friedel or my Daughter Margery one Guinea to be given to my gran-
daughter Ann. Finally I give to my Son John M. Levenson fifty to be
paid out of the first Gaile due of my Place to G. Howard. Finally I give
to my Daughter Jean M. Levenson married to James Finley twenty five
Pounds to be paid out of the two first Gailes due by William Giddings.
Finally I give to my Daughter Abigail M. Levenson & Mary M. Levenson each
of them thirty Pounds a piece out of the two last Gailes of my Place
of black man & lad of good man & lad and a lot to be given and
whoever gets the black man is to get three Pounds and three Rdings
of Cloas to their Mothers Pleasure. Lastly I make my Wife and my
Son Walter Executors of this my last Will & Testament and The M. Levenson
Gardner signed sealed published & retained in the presence
of us.

but of sound Memory (blessed be God) Do make & publish this my last
Will & Testament in Manner following. That is to say. I am First I
give & bequeath to my only beloved wife Elizabeth Mchulloch the third
of all my Lands & Chattels & the third of the Plantation on which I live
for Maintenance while she lives or while she remains a Widow or
cause to live on 2^d place. Also I give all the Plantation on which I live
to my son Samuel Mchulloch it being situate on y^e west of George
Dorison senior and consisting of three hundred & eighty six Acres
of Land to him & his Heirs Forever. I give to my son William Mchulloch
three hundred Acres of Land situate on y^e west of the Plantation
on which I live & to the south of his brother Shadrach Mchulloch

114 And also two Cows & Calves. - Also at the Rest & Residence of my
 Goods, Cattle & personal Estate whatsoever I allow to be equally di-
 vided betwixt my well beloved Sons John McWhorter, John McWhorter
 and Samuel McWhorter. Memorandum before the infolding hereof
 I also that forty Shillings shal be lawed of the above remaining
 two Parts of my Estate & given to my Grandson Matthew McWhorter.
 And also I make & ordain my dear Elizabeth McWhorter & John McWhorter
 whole & sole Executors of this my last Will. - In Witness whereof
 I, I James James McWhorter have to this my last Will & Testament

 in Body, yet of a sound & perfect Understanding and Memory
 blessed be God almighty God, for the same. Do constitute Judge and
 Appoint this my last Will & Testament and order and desire it may
 be received by all whom it may concern, as such. In witness I
 most humbly bequeath my Soul to God, my Maker Redeemer &
 Sanctifier, beseeching his most gracious Acceptance of it, through
 the precious Merit & Satisfaction of my most compassionate
 Saviour, Jesus Christ, who gave himself for my

 Resurrection from thence at the last Day. And as for my Personal, I wish it may
 be decent, without pomp or State, at the Discretion of my Executors herein
 after named who I doubt not, will manage it with all requisite Reverence and
 Gravity. And as to my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
 bless me, I will and positively order the same in the following manner and
 Form, (after Payment of all my Debts & Liabilities at Charge) Item I absolutely
 give bequeath devise & demise unto my well beloved & dear Son Charles the
 North half or Part of the Plantation on Liddle Creek which I purchased
 of Andrew Cuthbert, and two Horses, one Yellow & Tackle, and the largest
 Yoke, &c to his heirs & assigns forever. Item I give devise & demise and bequeath
 unto my well beloved Son Thomas, one half of the Plantation wherupon I
 now live, viz to be laid off joining the Line of Walter Learmonth, Esq^r and
 to his heirs & assigns forever. Item I give devise & demise and bequeath unto
 my well beloved Son William all my Tract of Land in the Town of Littleton
 joining the Lines of Daniel McWhorter, John McWhorter &c and two Horses
 a Yoke & Tackle and to his heirs & assigns forever. Item I give devise
 & bequeath unto my well beloved Son James, one half of the Plan-
 tation or Tract of Land on Liddle Creek which I purchased of Andrew
 Cuthbert, viz the South Side of said Tract, & one Horse to him his heirs and
 assigns forever. Item I give devise & bequeath unto my well
 beloved Son Hugh, my Negro Wench named Judith, and also all the
 Tract of Land I purchased of William Watson to him his heirs &
 assigns forever. Item I give devise & bequeath unto
