be divided among my Children as above mentioned

my Negro fellow Peter and my Negro Wench Sylva and
at her Death or Marriage I will that they be sold and
the money to be equally divided among all my Sons
also I give unto my wife my household furniture
horses Cattle and other stock and my plantation
Tools to be kept in the place for the support of her
self and family Also I give to my Daughter Jean
My Negro Nell Also I give to my Daughter Sarah
My Negro Dinah Also I give to my Daughter
Margaret

My Negro Sarah, Also I give to my son Samuel
A Survey of One thousand Acres of Land on the
Western Waters. Also I give an Entry of two
Thousand Acres of Land on the Western Waters
to be equally divided between all my Sons -

I do make and ordain my Son Samuel
and my Brother Richard Graham of this my Will,
in trust for the Intents and Purposes in this my
Will contained. In witness whereof I the said
John Graham have to this my last Will and
