

For her natural life time then I give & bequeath all that part of my land lying on the north side of cedar creek with half the water of the said creek or as near as may be to my sons Henry & Andrew to be divided by a line beginning at a forked maple tree standing on the north bank of said creek at the head of the braces pond running thence north course untill it strikes Thomas Estlin & all that part of my land lying on the south side of beades creek including my dwelling house & other improvements I give & bequeath unto my son Giles & after that part of my land lying on the north side of beades creek is divided by the above mentioned line, the west part of it is to belong to Andrew & the east part to Henry - I also give & bequeath unto my son Andrew one black horse colt with a saddle & bridle - then at the expiration of my widows widowhood or her natural life my will is that all & every part of my property then remaining shall be sold & equally divided except my land & those of her articles already mentioned amongst all my children sons & daughters, John, Charles, William Henry, Andrew & Giles as well Mary Lucy Elizabeth & Polly observing what my married daughters are already had of me, so as to make each of their share of my estate equal, if my executors should conceive there should be any part of my stock or any other property that should be necessary for the support of my widow & three small children my wish is that it

be sold & the money taken care of untill a division should take place. I require my executors to give my son Andrew six months schooling & my son Giles one year schooling out of my estate - also I leave eight Dollars out of my estate to be paid into the hands of the Deacon of the church at Eatons meeting house for the use of the church at the death of my widow. I ratify & confirm this & no other to be my last will & testament & I likewise constitute & ordain my son John William & Henry to be my sole executors to this my last will & test. In witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 13 day of February 1801

Secondly I give & bequeath my land to be equally divided betwix my two sons John Harwood & And Esquire Harwood to be at their sole will & disposal at their mother decease.

and Will^m executors of this my last will & testament
in witness whereof I the said John Harwood jun have

A.D: 1802 I Henry Hughey of N. Carolina in the County
of Rowan being very sick & weak in body but of perfect
mind & memory thanks be to God for the same & calling
to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my
last will & testament that is to say principally & first

of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God
that gave it & concerning my body I recommend it to the earth
to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my friends
nothing doubting but at the general resurrection to obtain
everlasting happiness through the merits of Jesus Christ.
And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it had pleased
God to bless me in this life to give devise & dispose of the same
in manner & form following that is to say.

In the first place I give & bequeath to Mary my dear be-
loved Mother & my brother Samuel & Andrew all my land
to be equally divided among them three, & my coat I leave
to my mother & to my brother Andrew like wise I leave
to my brother Andrew my Rifle gun & my clothes I leave
them to my mother to divide them as she thinks best
ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will
& testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal the day & year first above written
