After due consideration with my wife & Children concerning my Lands I allow George Willson my son to have the liberty to buy the Creek & have his Majesty laid out both equally divided between my son Michael Willson and Benjamin Willson as they shall agree if any dispute should arise they cannot agree my Executors it to divide it at their Discretion also that land at White Creek where I now live to be equally divided between my two sons Joseph & Jacob Willsons allowing Jacob the Round & Clear land now belonging to the farms allowing each son to make good their my last will as it now stands without my hand the day and year above written

In the Name of God Amen I Martin Newfang of Rowan County in the province of North Carolina before calling to mind the frailty and mortality of human life, (and that it is appointed for all men once to die, And being weak in body but in perfect mind and understanding, I do hereby make my last will & Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, First (and principally) I give my Soul to God who gave it me, (and my body) to the earth, there to be, decently according to the direction of my Executors hereafter before my wife & estate, as it hath pleased

God to bless me with; I give & bequeath as hereafter followeth. (211)

First I desire that all my just debts (and lawful debts) shall be paid. Secondly I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Anna Mary Newfang, the bed and Bedstead, the spinning wheel, the Chest and the Wheat, Corn and flax, that is now the place where herpet and by law.

Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter a few for Dish besides her share.

Fourthly I will that my son Matthew Newfang shall be educated (and brought up in the fear of God, and at the age of fifteen years he is to be bound to Trade such as he shall choose.

Fifthly I will that the improvement of Land shall be sold, (and the cash and other furniture, (and to this my last will (and Testament) I make (and appoint my beloved Father in Law, Felix Glat (Liber and Michael Haug my Lawful Executors to them last will and Testament, in Witness whereof, I have before these present Witnesses signed my own Hand, the 31st Day of May 77

God my maker, beseeching his most gracious acceptance of it,
thro' the merits and meditations, of my redeemer Jesus Christ
(and as to my worldly estate, I will and positively order that
all my debts be paid, first, I give to my dear and Loving Wife
Catherine Hincine my Iron Grey mare, (and likewise a new
saddle to be got for her out of my estate, likewise I will and
ordain that the plantation wherein I now live, to be entered as soon
as my Lord's office, is signed and grants to be got and to be divided
(and the costs amounting thereby to be paid and paid out of my
estate) (and the money left in the Executors hands, for that purpose
I likewise leave unto my dear and loving Wife the House
in which I now dwell, (and her third part of the plantation
or her to raise the Children while she remains a widow, next
I give unto my Son Jacob Hincine Eighty Acres of Land out
of the said Grant to witte ^{one} of that side he now lives on (and the
remaining part of the Land to be equally divided between my
Sons, Jacob, John, George, Christopher and Abraham
Hincine) to them and to Jacob, and to their heirs and assigns
forever. And to my debts due to me by my Debtors I will that
my Executors collect it (and as to the rest of my worldly
Goods, I will and positively order, that they be sold and the
amounting thereby, together with my debts
lastly by and to be equally divided

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Excepting my wife third among my children viz. my
son Jacob, Henry, John, George, Christopher, Abraham, Peter
Catherine, Elizabeth, Margaret, Christiane, Wendine. I
likewise constitute and ordain Joseph Bayan, and Jacob
Bot, my Executors, of this my last will and Testament
and Trustees for my ^{now} and children. In witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and Seal this twentieth day of
May. The year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven hundred
(and Seventy five).
