Item I give demise & bequeath to my loving daughter Margaret aforesaid my plantation which I bought of James Thomson & entered & surveyed the same since, I allow the deed to enure in her name, & also my small entry & survey on third creek, joining Jonathan Boons land, & to her heirs & assigns forever & also my plantation bought of John Johnson to her, her heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give demise & bequeath to my loving daughter Elizabeth aforesaid my plantation I bought of Alexander Douglas to her, her heirs & assigns forever.

Lastly I nominate ordain & appoint, my loving wife Mary, Samuel Young, & Thomas McKay executors of this my last will & test. hereby revoking & disannulling all other & former wills & test., legacies, bequeaths, devises & executors, by me heretofore made, ratifying & confirming this to be my last will & test.

In the name of God Amen! I John Lowasser of Rowan County in the State of N^C. Carolina farmer being very sick in body, but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God. Do this 24th day of April 1794. Make & publish this my last will & test. in the manner & form following that is to say.

First I give unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth Lowasser whom I constitute & appoint my executor her bed & furniture there to belonging & her spinning wheel, & one choice of all my horse creatures, & two cows her choice, of all my personal property; & shall keep her possession of the plantation I now live on; during the time she will remain my widow & bare my name - & concerning all my other household property to me belonging I desire that my executors shall sell as much as will pay all just debts, & the remainder I desire my wife shall keep to support her self & my children, but if she should marry or die I desire it shall all be sold, and equally divided amongst my children, as they shall come of age, excepting my daughter Catharin I give her ten pounds more than any of the others & concerning my lands & tenements; after her death or if she should marry I desire my executors, shall rent the said lands from year to year until my youngest child shall be of age - then I desire my lands & tenements shall be sold by my executor at public sale & time & credit given for the payment thereof as they shall think proper, then my daughter Catharina I give ten pounds, extra, the remainder I desire that it shall all be equal divided amongst my wife & all my children. Further I do hereby make & ordain my worthy friend Jacob Fisher

Executor, with my wife, of this my last will & test: in witness

of my estate besides what I have already given him the
sum of ten pounds & no more to him & his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Samuel Luckey all my
land lying on the west side of Hunting creek including my
improvements wherupon I now live & ten pounds currency
besides what I have already given him & no more to him, his
heirs & assigns forever.

Item I will that all my moveable property that is to say
horses, cows, hogs, sheep, household furniture & my two negroes
named Steve & Dinah shall be put to sale & the money equally
divided between my three daughters namely Eleonor McQuire
& Ann Luckey & Mary Luckey, only out of such money
arising from such property. I give to my granddaughter Ann
Ronsaw whom she comes to the age of sixteen years the sum
of five pounds, to them their heirs & assigns forever.

And lastly I do nominate & appoint my son Samuel Luckey
& my son in law James McQuire executors of this my last
will & testament
