I do will and bequeath unto my son Joseph to have and to hold it forever all my Lands. 2^d I do will and bequeath unto my loving wife Catharine to remain upon the same plantation in full power during the time she remains my Widow &c

I do will and bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna two Hundred pounds to be raised out of my moveable Estate. 4th I do will and bequeath unto my son

Joseph two Negroes namely Jack and Dinah.

5th I do will and bequeath unto my wife Catharine one Negro Girl named Hannah. 6th I will and bequeath unto my wife Catharine one hundred pounds raised out of my Estate. 7th I will and bequeath

unto my wife Catharine two Negroes, namely Jack and Dinah during her Widowhood and if she marries before my son Joseph is of the age of Twenty one years then the 3^d Negroes and Land to be unto my Executors and as for the remaining part of my Estate to be equally divided between my

and my two Children Joseph & Susanna &c I do appoint my friends Jacob Waggoner and Valentine Leonard my Executors of this my last will and Testament Given under my Hand and seal this 27th day of November

1790-

In the name of God Amen the thirtieth day of November in the year of our Lord 1788 I John Luckey of the County of Rowan in the state of North Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be given unto God, therefore calling this to mind the frailty of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make & ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say principally and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it & for my body I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors not doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God: and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give & devise the same in the following manner and form.

42 First, I leave my land lying along John Beyans
line to be sold at public sale and the money to be
equally divided between my three brothers James
Lucky, Robert Lucky and George Lucky after
my just debts are paid upon this paying my sister
Mary Lucky, my sister Leaba Lucky and my sister
Jean Lucky one third of each of their parts from the
sale of the land. I give & bequeath to my brother
Robert Lucky my hat likewise my brother George
Lucky I give & bequeath all my wearing apparel
and a Colt, likewise my sister Mary Lucky I
give & bequeath one feather bed & furniture, Thomas
Penny & Isaac Jones I constitute & appoint Execu-
tors of this my last will & Testament, and I do hereby
attest & solemnly swear & disannul all and every
other former Testaments Wills and Legacies Bequests
and Executors by me in any way before this time
made & void & bequeathed ratifying & confirming
this & no other to be my last will & Testament.

it is appointed for all men once to die do make &
ordain this my last will & Testament, that is to say
